Dear Church,

Like Jesus, Ezekiel is sent to stubborn, obstinate people. His calling is to speak God's word to people who are not going to be able to hear it. God prepares him for the potential of rejection, but assures him that his mission is based on truth. Ezekiel is assured he will have an impact, even if it is not the full conversion to which he calls the Israelites. Sometimes God does not work all at once but in increments.

The whirlwind pace of Mark's Gospel includes lots of admiring crowds pressing around Jesus; it often seems he cannot get away from those who want to be near him and have access to his healing and preaching. In this gospel, though, he is met with skepticism. He returns to his hometown—a place where many of us hope to be embraced and have our accomplishments celebrated. But those who knew him as a child cannot accept who he has grown into. Their presuppositions prevent them from encountering what others have found in him. We, too, can make assumptions about what we think we know. It is all too easy to miss God's work, which often breaks into the mundane in surprising ways. God does not always work in ways we would expect.

Como Jesús, Ezequiel es enviado a gente testaruda y obstinada. Su llamado es hablar la palabra de Dios a personas que no podrán escucharla. Dios lo prepara para el potencial del rechazo, pero le asegura que su misión se basa en la verdad. Ezequiel está seguro de que tendrá un impacto, aunque no sea la conversión total a la que llama a los israelitas. A veces Dios no obra todo a la vez sino en incrementos.

El ritmo vertiginoso del Evangelio de Marcos incluye muchas multitudes admiradoras que se apiñan alrededor de Jesús; a menudo parece que no puede alejarse de quienes quieren estar cerca de él y tener acceso a su curación y predicación. Sin embargo, en este evangelio se encuentra con escepticismo. Regresa a su ciudad natal, un lugar donde muchos de nosotros esperamos ser abrazados y celebrar nuestros logros. Pero quienes lo conocieron de niño no pueden aceptar en quién se ha convertido. Sus presupuestos les impiden encontrar lo que otros han encontrado en él. Nosotros también podemos hacer suposiciones sobre lo que creemos saber. Es muy fácil pasar por alto la obra de Dios, que a menudo irrumpe en lo mundano de maneras sorprendentes. Dios no siempre obra de la manera que esperaríamos.

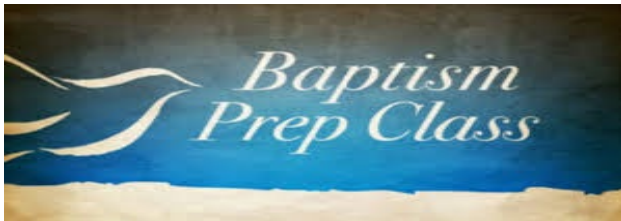
