Stewarding Our Talents Together

"You do realize that when I say "you need to do this" I am really saying that this needs to get done (not by you alone), don't you?" I was a new pastoral staff member, still learning the ins and outs of parish ministry, and on this particular day I must have looked as overwhelmed as I sometimes felt. My pastor had said yet again, "you need to do this," and I am sure my face told the tale. Interiorly, I was thinking, "I cannot do another thing!" And my pastor recognized this. His response, telling me that the details of the ministry were not for me to bear alone taught me a remarkable lesson: ministry is about applying the talents and gifts God gives to each of us. It is about learning to steward those talents together, recognizing that it will take all of us doing what we can in order to touch the world with the love of Christ. As leaders, we often fall into the trap of thinking that if it is going to get done (whatever "it" might be), it will have to be done by us. Otherwise, we rationalize, it may not be done well, or at all, and it will certainly not be done our way. In working with parish leadership groups, I often meet people who admit that they are only serving in a particular ministry or leading an organization because Father or a staff member or friend asked them to. Often, we fill ministry roles by looking at the "slots" to fill: what needs to get done; how many people do we need; who might be willing to take this on? We rarely begin with talent, considering the particular qualities of people and inviting them to discern which ministries might be a good fit. And yet, this is the way that will lead people to serve with passion, energy, and with less burn out. Ministries flourish, as do the people who serve within them. And in this life-giving way of ministry, we bring Christ's love to life through our good and faithful stewardship.

Administrando nuestros talentos juntos

"Te das cuenta de que cuando digo "necesitas hacer esto", realmente estoy diciendo que esto debe hacerse (no solo por ti), ¿no?" Era un nuevo miembro del personal pastoral, todavía aprendía los entresijos del Ministerio de la Parroquia, y en este día en particular debo haber parecido tan abrumado como a veces sentía. Mi pastor había dicho una vez más: "Necesitas hacer esto", y estoy seguro de que mi cara le contó el cuento. Interior, estaba pensando: "¡No puedo hacer otra cosa!" Y mi pastor reconoció esto. Su respuesta, diciéndome que los detalles del ministerio no eran para soportar solo, me enseñaron una lección notable: el ministerio se trata de aplicar los talentos y los dones que Dios nos da a cada uno de nosotros. Se trata de aprender a administrar esos talentos juntos, reconociendo que nos llevará a todos hacer lo que podamos para tocar el mundo con el amor de Cristo. Como líderes, a menudo caemos en la trampa de pensar que si se va a hacer (sea lo que sea "que sea"), nos hará hacer nosotros. De lo contrario, racionalizamos, puede que no se haga bien, o en absoluto, y ciertamente no se hará nuestro camino. Al trabajar con grupos de liderazgo parroquial, a menudo conozco a personas que admiten que solo están sirviendo en un ministerio en particular o liderando una organización porque el padre o un miembro del personal o un amigo les pidieron. A menudo, ocupamos los roles del ministerio mirando las "máquinas tragamonedas" para llenar: lo que debe hacerse; ¿Cuántas personas necesitamos? ¿Quién podría estar dispuesto a asumir esto? Raramente comenzamos con talento, considerando las cualidades particulares de las personas e invitándolas a discernir qué ministerios podrían encajar bien. Y, sin embargo, esta es la forma en que llevará a las personas a servir con pasión, energía y menos agotamiento. Los ministerios florecen, al igual que las personas que sirven dentro de ellos. Y en esta forma de ministerio que da vida, le damos a la vida el amor de Cristo a través de nuestra administración buena y fiel.
