### A Message from Our Pastor:

This short instruction is from the Rite for the Baptism of Infants:

“Parents: You have asked to have your child baptized. In doing so you are accepting the responsibility of training him(her) in the practice of the faith. It will be your duty to bring him(her) up to keep God’s commandments as Christ taught us, by loving God and our neighbor.” I quote this because it is Catechetical Sunday. In a very real way, you are the first catechists of your children. It is your duty to bring them up to keep God’s commandments as Christ taught us. By your word and example, you form them in the faith. Thank you for taking on this responsibility.

I’m sure you have heard the saying: It takes a village to raise a child. I would tweak this to say that it takes a community of faith to raise a Christian. 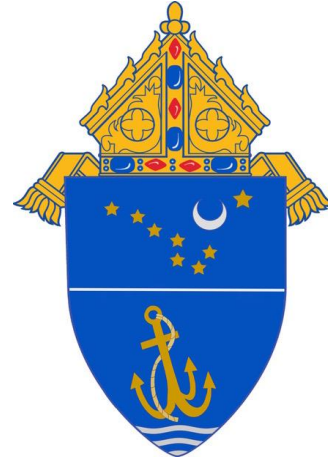
