

STEWARDSHIP

TIME ✦ TALENT ✦ TREASURE ✦

In today's Gospel Jesus makes a bold and clear statement to his disciples. "I give you a new commandment: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." We are called to love others as a sign of our discipleship in Jesus Christ. That includes even those "others" we might prefer to forget. We are so often tempted to draw lines between those who we will love and those who we consider not worthy of our love. This week take time to reflect on Jesus' love command. How often do we heed Jesus' love command? What change in our lives must take place in order for us to obey this command?

As Christian stewards we are aware of the beauty and meaning of the seasons in the liturgical calendar. The Easter season remains a special time for recommitment to the Lord. One word for this period is "mystagogia," which means that we delve more deeply into the mystery of our faith. As we prepare for Pentecost, we prayerfully examine what the Resurrection means in our own lives. To the Christian steward, it is a time to reevaluate how faith in the Risen Lord informs every aspect of our compassion to others. If Christ is truly risen – an astounding and life altering belief – then this Easter time brings immense joy and a continuing desire to know the Risen Lord.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús hace una declaración contundente y clara a sus discípulos: «Les doy un mandamiento nuevo: que se amen los unos a los otros. Como yo los he amado, que también ustedes se amen los unos a los otros. En esto conocerán todos que son mis discípulos, si se aman los unos a los otros». Estamos llamados a amar a los demás como signo de nuestro discipulado en Jesucristo. Esto incluye incluso a esos «otros» que preferimos olvidar. Con frecuencia nos vemos tentados a trazar una línea divisoria entre quienes amaremos y quienes consideramos indignos de nuestro amor. Esta semana, dediquemos un tiempo a reflexionar sobre el mandato de amor de Jesús. ¿Con qué frecuencia lo obedecemos? ¿Qué cambio debe ocurrir en nuestras vidas para obedecer este mandato?

Como cristianos corresponsables, somos conscientes de la belleza y el significado de los tiempos litúrgicos. El tiempo de Pascua sigue siendo un tiempo especial para renovar nuestro compromiso con el Señor. Una palabra para este período es «mistagogia», que significa que profundizamos en el misterio de nuestra fe. Al prepararnos para Pentecostés, examinamos con oración el significado de la Resurrección en nuestras vidas. Para el cristiano corresponsable, es un momento para reevaluar cómo la fe en el Señor Resucitado influye en cada aspecto de nuestra compasión hacia los demás. Si Cristo realmente resucitó —una creencia asombrosa que transforma la vida—, entonces este tiempo de Pascua nos trae una inmensa alegría y un deseo constante de conocer al Señor Resucitado.




