Availability List, May 2026

Occasionally we have excesses of certain plants which are surplus to our projects at any given time (or are just very good doers!). These are listed here- email enquiries@kilbygardens.com for information and prices. As well, we may be able to supply plants not listed here, from our own stock or through our links with trade and other specialist growers.

- *Rosa mundi*
Gallica rose with scented, striped fuchsia/pink/white flowers, once flowering June. Wonderful. Bare root.
- *Matthiola incana 'alba'*
Perennial, white-flowered stock. Wonderful scent, felty grey leaves, hardy...ish, messy...ish!
- *Geranium x oxonianum 'Pearl Boland'*
Good doer, dark green leaves with attractive markings. Pink to white veined flowers all summer.
- *Crocus speciosus*
Autumn-flowering *Crocus*. Purple flowers with blue veining and orange anthers. Saffron.
- *Rudbeckia laciniata 'Herbstonne'*
Large perennial coneflower to 2.5m, green to yellow, then brown flowers 10cm across. Stands well through the Winter, wants soil that doesn't dry out.
- *Persicaria amplexicaulis 'alba'*
Tough, good doer. Perennial Bistort. Spires of pink/white flowers from July to November
- *Pelargonium sidoides*
Velvet-like, magenta flowers produced all summer. Grey scalloped leaves, tough as Pelargoniums go- I have a few which overwinter in big troughs all year.
- *Galanthus elwesii var. monostictus*
Large-flowered snowdrop, good glaucous leaves, flowering from mid-November onwards. A very useful asset in the Winter Garden. Lifted and potted dormant in July. Original stock from Ivycroft Nurseries.
- *Bupleureum fruticosum*
Shrubby Hare's Ear. One of my favourite shrubs. Evergreen, rounded shape with zesty-green flowers in July. Seems hardy these days. Seedlings from nursery stock plant. P9
- *Symphotrichum leave 'Arcturus'*
(Aster). Tall, vigorous dark-stemmed aster. Pale blue flowers in Aug-Sept. Good back of border or in rough grass. Potted 2L
- Yellow Rattle
Rhinanthus minor. The 'meadow maker'. Annual with yellow flowers, essential in reducing grass strength when making meadows. Small volumes of Herefordshire hand-harvested seed. Dried seed
- Mixed *Helleborus x hybridus* seedlings
Seed ex. *Helleborus x hybridus*. Various available, strains of pink, white and pale yellow. Seed ex stock plants. Could be interesting flowers. P9
- *Digitalis ferruginea*
Rusty/copper flowered foxgloves. Short lived perennial, very classy. P9
