There are many female mystics, and we will explore these three in-depth over this weekend.



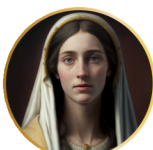
Saint Hildegard of Bingen

Saint Hildegard of Bingen was a Christian mystic and Benedictine Abbess who was also an artist, author, composer, pharmacist, poet, preacher and theologian. St. Hildegard began receiving mystical visions at the young age of 3. These visions caused her to see human beings as "living sparks" of God's love.



Teresa of Avila

Saint Teresa of Avila was a powerful woman due to her rare combination of intense mystical spirituality, fearless determination as a reformer, and sharp intellect as a writer, allowing her to establish 17 new convents and modernize the Carmelite Order despite fierce opposition. She was a prominent Counter-Reformation figure who empowered women to lead, becoming one of the first female Doctors of the Church.



Mary Magdalene

Mary Magdalene embodied the struggles, representing resilience and transformation. Explore her spiritual meaning and how her journey can inspire your own path toward self-discovery and empowerment. Understanding her significance might just change the way you view your own spiritual journey.
