


Q3 If you have a business in Mundy Township, how long have you been in business?

Q4 What is your age?




Q5 What do you value the most about living, working, or visiting Mundy Township? (Select all that apply)







Q6 Why do you live, work, or frequent Mundy Township? (Select all that apply)






Q7 Which of the following issues do you think should be the highest priorities during the Master Plan Update (select no more than 3)?





Q9 Do you believe Mundy Township should seek to provide more housing options like townhouses, senior housing, and apartments in appropriate locations?






Q10 If you answered yes to Question 9, what types of housing do you feel are most appropriate?




Q12 Would you like to see a downtown-like area developed within Mundy Township that includes a mix of businesses, restaurants, and housing in a walkable environment?
