::: How to End Racism/White Supremacy

Racism was and is an attack on Africa and Black People. It has an adverse impact on others, and has been in effect for so long, until it has become a deadly disease. No one person or group can address the issue affectively. It will take a collective effort on the part of Blacks, Whites, Jews, and all others to maintain persistent agitation through using your platforms to shed light on both issues of racism and police terrorism. We should continue to (1) **protest in mass numbers, in many places simultaneously**, so everyone sees **most people in America want** (2) **to have dialogue to slowly dissolve and eventually end racism and police terrorism**, so that we can live together in peace in a civil society. {{The combination of **both forces** working in unison, with the same goal of liberating blacks from racism, while protesting police and racist people killing blacks, is a movement}}. I sincerely thank all of the people who have been hosting dialogue and conducting protests to bring these issues to light, especially the Concerned Black Men and Women, Top Athletes, and all others. This activity should continue for 5 consecutive years to be effective.

I cannot tell you how many people have called me to say how much they appreciate blacks and others collectively addressing both issues. It is a powerful scenario that I hope all parties continue to utilize for the best interest of African-Americans as victims of racism, just like they did back in the Civil Rights Movement (CRM). Because the struggle continues as we really are fighting for the same basic rights like equality, and against police and supremacist unjustly killing blacks, like we confronted back in the CRM. We have a great advantage now working in unison. It has never happened before. We always had Civil Rights Groups vs Black Power Groups issues, Black Men vs Black Women issues, and now Old School vs Hip Hop lyrics. Fortunately, the urgency to address both issues has toppled our differences, so that we can continue to work towards unity and liberation by forming the African-American Reparations/Sovereignty (AARS) Congress.

My background and the three Groups

My siblings and I were blessed being raised by navy parents sacrificing and providing, while emphasizing church and education. That support system led me to develop visions of helping others. After 40 years of research on Black History, Racism, and Reparations I became a Social Scientist, then produced two products, (a book/CD & DVD), to educate America on racism, and to introduce sustainable solutions. I used my products to create an AAIU agenda and the AARS plan to achieve this goal.

1 Now as a youngster I had basketball skills and became a Legend at Verbum Dei in Watts. I played
2 in the Final Four with UCLA in 1980, then played and retired in Switzerland in '93. I went back
3 to UCLA at the end of '93 to get my Sociology Degree, and work at Camp Kilpatrick as a Group
4 Supervisor, the detention facility where they filmed the Grid Iron Gang movie. My high regards
5 for sports and discipline lifted my visions of helping others. Collective dialogue on my products
6 to dissolve racism, ease racial tensions, and improve police relations will help all of America now.

8 The problem with dialogue on racism is America has a repressive tactic to use rich, famous, and
9 publicity seeking people to participate, **to pacify the people**, instead of using those of us who are
10 qualified, **to produce viable solutions**. We are forming the African-American Reparations/
11 Sovereignty AARS Congress, to help blacks, win reparations, and as a diverse power group to
12 solve lingering and mounting problems. We can stop this well-known repressive tactic by utilizing
13 the AAIU agenda, and AARS plan, suggesting participants should understand the reasons for, and
14 activities of, the Civil Rights Movement, and have at least 20 years of experience studying
15 pertinent issues particularly God, civilizations, history, populations, racism, slavery, societies,
16 reform systems, problem solving, and reparations.

18 We are forming the Sports Entertainment and Education Group (SEEG), for blacks and others who
19 are rich, famous, professionals, and college graduates, to keep God first and to use your resources
20 and intelligence with our business plan, with no risk of losing your money, to practice collective
21 economics, that will generate wealth for great personal or group profit, and help us build safe cities.
22 With racism and police terrorism noticeably rising blacks are not safe, so they should build safe
23 sovereign cities. That sanctions blacks to live in integrated, and safe sovereign cities in America.
24 We need the valuable group of pastors, spiritual leaders, athletes, politicians, and rich and blessed
25 people, to be obedient to God. Most people love this group, but they are engaging way too much
26 foul language and activity. It is a bad influence causing deterioration and separation of the good
27 social fabric of liberties in America, it is contributing to the decline of spirituality in society, and
28 it shows a lack of care and concern for your fellow man. We love you, so show us some love.

29 We need this valuable group to set an example for the rest of the world by letting everyone know
30 they really love, honor, and respect God, his commandments, and/or his laws, ways, and language
31 for life. Now this change and improving America's dialogue on racism can be the beginning of a
32 positive change for people in America, and the rest of the world. Change will come from top to
33 bottom, not bottom to top. We need this valuable group, and especially the police, the general
34 population, and everybody on earth, to start giving more respect to people of different races.

35 Addressing racism without an agenda or plan is a historical problem blacks face that prevents them
36 from finding solutions for their problems. That is the main reason why they are stuck in poverty-
37 stricken neighborhoods, with very poor social conditions today. The AAIU agenda and AARS plan
38 has guidelines that will lead to honest dialogue to produce viable solutions.

39 It is important for us to designate blacks and others who are qualified and prepared; to participate
40 in the AARS Dialogue on Racism; to move in the same name and spirit of great Black; White; and

1 Jewish Freedom Fighters; of the Civil Rights Movement; who worked and walked together for
2 blacks to get equal opportunities; and to stop being brutally killed by the police and supremacist!
