Day 1 - Arrival	- Bus transfer from the airport to your hotel. Day 3 - ECEC (Early Childhood Education and Care)	 Morning: Job shadowing in a kindergarten (please bring warm clothes for outdoor activities with the children). Afternoon: Mini-seminar on ECEC, covering topics such as the importance of free play, socio-emotional growth, and diverse learning environments. Design and shopping tour: visits to littala & Arabia Design Center and Marimekko outlet.
