- Question #9: How does the hymn "We Saw Thee Not" by Anne Richter (Song #167 in Hymns For Worship) encourage us to walk by faith and not by sight?
- Question #10: What does it mean to be spiritually blind (2 Pet. 1:9; Rev. 3:17)?
