

Lesson 7: That You May Believe That Jesus Is The Christ

"And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; ³¹ but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name" (Jn. 20:30-31).

- Question #1: What was the ultimate purpose of Jesus working signs, wonders, and miracles (Jn. 20:30-31)?
- Question #2: What does Jesus' ability to change water to wine prove Jesus has the power to change (Jn. 2:1-12)?
- Question #3: What does Jesus' ability to raise the physically dead prove Jesus can do for the spiritually dead (Lk. 7:14-15; Jn. 11:43-44; Eph. 2:1-2)?
- Question #4: What does Jesus' ability to calm the winds and sea prove Jesus can do in the lives of men (Matt. 8:23-27)?
- Question #5: What does Jesus' ability to provide physical bread prove Jesus can provide spiritually (Matt. 15:32-39; John 6:35)?
- Question #6: What did the multitude do and say after Jesus forgave and healed a paralytic in Matthew 9:8?
- Question #7: What did the 5000 say about Jesus in John 6:14?
- Question #8: What did some do when they witnessed Jesus' miracles (Jn. 11:45)?
- Question #9: Does something that seems to be unexplainable today necessarily make it a miracle?
- Question #10: What was the duration of miracles (1 Cor. 13:10; Jude 3; 2 Tim. 3:16-17)?
