The Federal Aviation Administration requires 40 hours of total flight time for the Private Pilot certificate. This is typically broke down into 20 hours of Flight Instruction and 20 hours of Solo flight time. During this time the student pilot will complete and meet the requirements to qualify to take the Private Pilot Practical Exam.
