Healthcare and Social Assistance: among the largest contributors to job creation in CA, mainly in home health assistants, personal care assistants, and registered nurses.

Technology and Professional Services:

Continuous progress & focus in artificial intelligence, cybersecurity, and research investment.

Construction and Infrastructure: The state is financing heavily renewable energy projects and infrastructure improvements.

Manufacturing and Logistics: Particularly in areas like the Inland Empire, due to constant claims for goods and transportation service areas.

Educational Services and Public Sector: predicted to continue to stabilize or grow, mainly in higher education and local government roles.


