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Detox at Recovery Point Acute Care

A 7-90 day social model residential drug and alcohol detox center.

Welcome to Recovery Point Detox

Recovery Point Acute Care is a 7 day social model residential detox designed to meet the needs of clients who face severe addiction to drugs, and/or alcohol and assists them in remaining drug-free.



Recovery Point Detox provides a safe and protected residential environment for clients suffering from withdrawal symptoms who are unable to build a clean and sober foundation of their own.

After 7 day detox transition into a 30 day up to 90 day residential treatment could be offered if the resident meets criteria for that level of care.

Recovery Point initiates sobriety for its clients to begin permanent recovery from drug or alcohol abuse while attending private counseling sessions. All staff hold membership in an addiction counselor board of California accredited agency.

Intake Information

The intake process begins with making a phone call to behavior wellness access line 888-868-1649 to determine suitability for services. This interview must be completed by the person to whom services will be given.

Services are paid by cencal medical insurance and active medical eligibility In Santa Barbara County is needed to pay for services. Services are not provided to out of Santa Barbara county residents.

Residents are subject to drug/alcohol testing and possession of drugs or alcohol is a condition of termination.

Clients are observed for 72 hours upon intake.

Good Samaritan's Policy Statement clearly states that verbal or physical abuse towards staff or residents is grounds for discharge.



Detox is not a "cure".

Going through detox means you have taken a big first step in getting free of drugs or alcohol. The drugs or alcohol may be gone from your body, but the people, places and problems that led you to drink and abuse drugs are still there. However, detox is only the beginning. Enrolling into a next level of care which outpatient and/or residential program may be the next step to maintain your sobriety.'

Recovery Point maintains its client's permanent recovery through 12-step program participation and aftercare including barrier-free relapse treatment.
