## Our Story

Good Samaritan Shelter first came into existence as a temporary evening shelter for the homeless in various area churches. Under the guidance of the North County Project Group, non-profit Good Samaritan Shelter was established in 1987. On January 31, 1988 the 28-bed modular shelter at 406 S Pine Street began providing services. Our new shelter, located on West Morrison, officially opened December 5, 2003. This program has grown from a 76-bed year-round emergency shelter to a current 90 bed shelter with additional veteran and overflow space. Good Samaritan pioneered and continues a successful working partnership with hundreds of citizens and volunteers from more than 32 churches and service organizations.

The mission of Good Samaritan Shelter is to provide emergency, transitional and affordable housing with support services to the homeless and those in recovery across the central coast.



Good Samaritan celebrates and fosters relationships that create wellness, and wholeness, in an environment of hope, within every human being.

Good Samaritan Shelter offers a range of services to those in need throughout the Central Coast.

Medical and Mental Health Screening

Case Management & Counseling

Drug & Alcohol Treatment

Our staff attend regular training sessions and conduct an extensive community outreach effort.

Our staff, volunteers, community, and Board of Directors have given Good Samaritan an invaluable reputation for service and concern to the needy.

## Services & Programs

### Emergency Shelter

Good Samaritan's Emergency Shelter is located at 401 W Morrison Ave. in Santa Maria, CA. This 90-bed shelter provides temporary housing for up to 90 days. Additional bed space includes a veterans program and overflow shelter. During inclement weather, a warming center is operated.

### Bridge House Shelter

The Bridge House Shelter is located at 2025 Sweeney Rd. in Lompoc, CA. This 82-bed shelter provides temporary housing for up to 90 days. Additional bed space includes a clean and sober living home and family shelter. During inclement weather, a warming center is operated.

### Family Shelter

Good Samaritan's Family Shelter is located at 401 W Morrison Ave., Building C. The family shelter was developed in response to the growing need of a program to assist families who are in limbo due to socio and economic hardship. This two-year program allows families with children to work closely with a case manager to attain various life skills so that the family may successfully transition into independent living.

### Transitional Center for Women & Children

This 20-bed residence assists young mothers who are in recovery from substance abuse, to develop skills in parenting, home management, nutrition, health, and economic independence.

### Project PREMIE

Project PREMIE is a non-residential program designed for expectant and postpartum mothers who are addicted to drugs and alcohol. The objective is to enable the mothers to deliver drug-free babies and then remain drug-free.

### Detox

Recovery Point Detox is located at 401 W Morrison Ave., Building B in Santa Maria.

It is a 7-14 day social model residential detox facility, designed to meet the needs of clients suffering from withdrawal symptoms in a clean and safe environment, and with 24-hour staff supervision and support.

### After School Program

The After School Program is located at 401 W Morrison Ave., Building C in Santa Maria, CA. Developed in conjunction with the Santa Barbara County Education Office and currently in partnership with Fighting Back Santa Maria Valley, the After School Program meets the unique educational needs of homeless children. The program is operated Monday-Friday 2:30-5:00PM and from 1:30-5:00 PM on Thursdays. A seasonal winter camp and summer camp program are also offered.

### Clean and Sober Living Homes

Good Samaritan provides three Clean and Sober Living homes for men and women in recovery.

### Recovery Point

Recovery Point is an outpatient program designed to assist clients in becoming, and remaining drug-free. It is located at 245 E Inger Drive, Suite 103-B.
