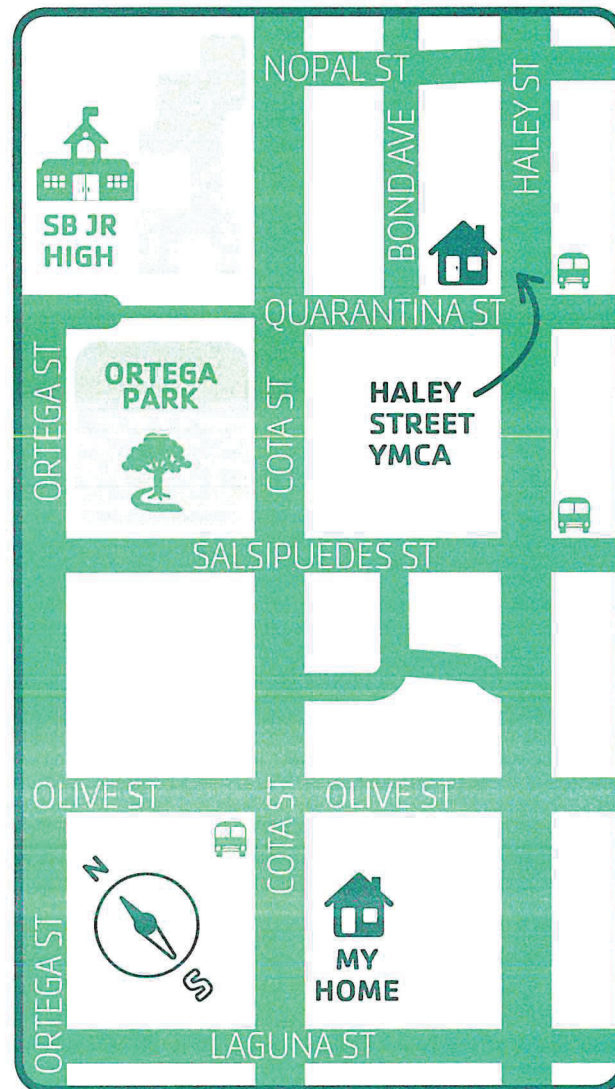

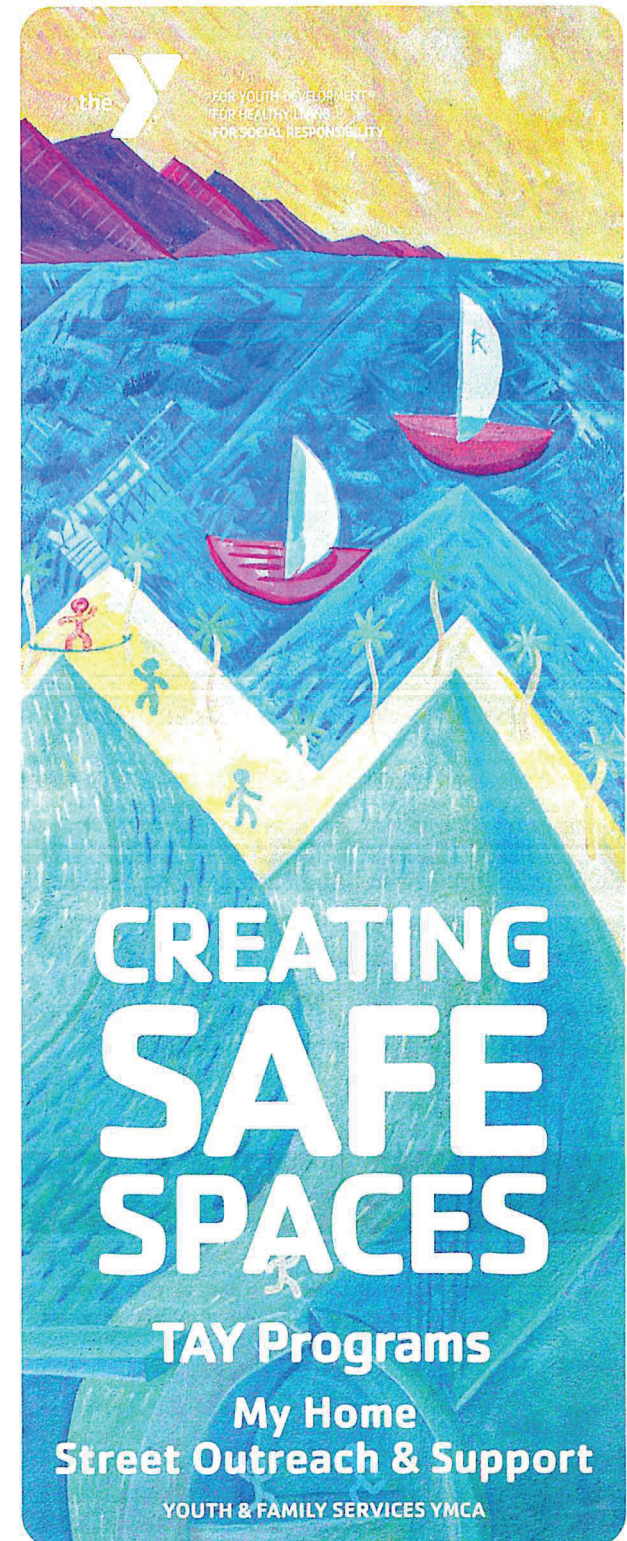

WE'RE HERE FOR YOU

TAY (Transitional Age Youth) Programs, Street Outreach & Support and My Home provide multiple noncommittal, low barrier services to youth 24 and younger designed to support the progression of their goals in a way that meets their current stage of change, motivation, and level of need. SOS provides basic needs and lower levels of case-management, support, and referrals, whilst My Home provides more intensive case-management related to independent living skills and youth identified long term goals.

Are you, or do you know someone 24 or younger who might need support getting their needs met as they transition into adulthood?

TAY PROGRAMS

Street Outreach & Support

The YMCA provides support to youth and young adults age 12-24 who are homeless or at risk for becoming homeless. Staff provide resources in the community via a mobile outreach team and at our drop-in center located at Haley St SOS.

- Intensive case-management support to identify and work towards achieving goals such as securing housing, receive education support, employment support, physical and mental health support and referrals, financial management literacy, and access to additional resources
