Opportunities

As the construction industry faces persistent labor shortages and economic uncertainty, leaders are urged to adopt a "builder's mindset"— one rooted in adaptability, strategic foresight, and workforce resilience 1. Meanwhile, transportation costs remain relatively stable, with <u>June 2025 gasoline</u> <u>prices</u> averaging \$3.15 per gallon—down nearly 9% from last year—though

diesel prices have seen a modest uptick2. In a significant boost to infrastructure, <u>U.S. Transportation Secretary Sean P. Duffy</u>announced nearly \$500 million in BUILD grants to fund 30 projects nationwide, targeting road safety, transit upgrades, and port enhancements3. Together, these developments signal both challenges and opportunities for the construction and transportation sectors.
