**REF:** Request for assistance in building a bicycle and motorbike workshop for students of Run Ta Ek High School.

Run Ta Ek High School is located in Ta Ek Village, Run Ta Ek Commune, Banteay Srei District, Siem Reap Province, Cambodia, in a rural area about 20 km northeast of Siem Reap City and 15 km east of Angkor Wat. Run Ta Ek High School has an influx of students from Run Ta Ek commune and other communes such as Tbeng commune, Romchek commune, Preah Dak commune. Google maps give the coordinates as: 390261, 1488126 Run Ta Ek High School is managed by the principal, Mr. Chay Khoch. Land for center donated

By the villagers and Run Ta Ek High School was built in 2011 with the contribution of the community. Run Ta Ek High School has 916 students, 534 girls. Currently, classes are from 7 am to 5 pm, meaning from 7th to 9th grade, from 7 to 12 o'clock, and 10th to 12th grade from 12 to 5:00. The number of students is increasing every year.

The greatest needs for this Thmat Pong Community Centre are:

1. Build a shed for bicycles and motorbikes for students, size 8 meters by 30 meters, roof Zinc and iron rods.
  2. Room for storing equipment for repairing student bicycles and motorbikes
- Villagers will provide the labor free of charge for building the extension.

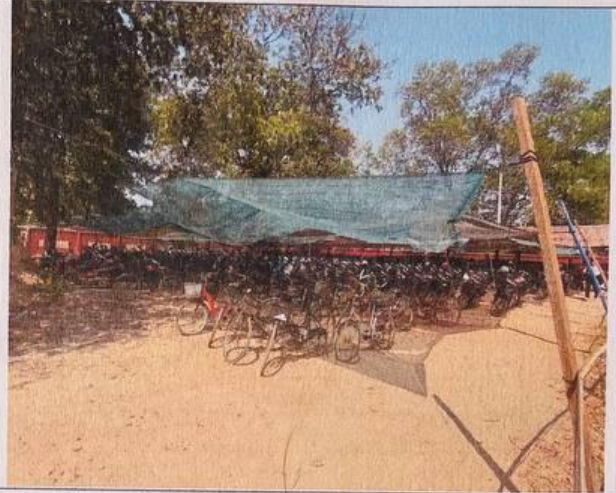

**REF:** Request Assistance for Constructing One School Building

The Chak Primary School, located in Chak village, Chak commune, Baribour district, Kampong Chhnang province, serves a student population of 228, with 111 female students. Situated 35 km from Kampong Chhnang town, the school's geographic coordinates are 12.4526177529564, and 104.4432202126845, firmly placing it within the local community it serves.

The Chak Primary School encompasses a substantial area of 103,166 square meters and comprises two buildings with a total of 10 classrooms. The first building, dedicated to secondary education, consists of 5 classrooms graciously donated by His Majesty King Norodom Sihamoni. The second building accommodates primary and community kindergarten classes, with one room serving as an office, and another as a library. The remaining three classrooms are utilized for morning and evening study sessions for children.

Despite the school management's efforts, the limited number of classrooms has necessitated the implementation of a two-shift system to accommodate 228 children seeking education at the Chak Primary School. This arrangement, while commendable in its attempt to provide conducive educational opportunities, presents significant challenges. Teachers face difficulties in maintaining a clean and conducive learning environment as each classroom is used for two separate sessions, one in the morning and another in the afternoon.

Currently, the school faces significant challenges in expanding its facilities to better serve the student population due to the following reasons:

1. Insufficient budgetary allocation for the construction of additional school buildings.
2. Lack of support from local and international philanthropic organizations to fund the construction of new buildings.
3. Unavailability of dedicated funds specifically earmarked for the construction of school buildings.

To address the pressing need for additional classroom space and provide a conducive learning environment for all students, Chak Primary School is actively seeking financial assistance to construct new school buildings. The school hopes that with sufficient funding, it can eliminate the need for the current two-shift system, allowing all students to attend classes during regular school hours and receive an adequate qualitative education without prejudice. It also enables students to utilize their afternoons for other extracurricular activities, including English tuition or any other beneficial activities.

Therefore, the school is earnestly reaching out to TLCB, appealing for their generous support and financial aid to make this vision a reality. With their invaluable contributions, the Chak Primary School can provide a brighter future for the children it serves, equipping them with the tools and knowledge they need to thrive and succeed in their academic pursuits and beyond.

While the total estimated cost for constructing the new school building is \$6,461.50, we are proposing a budget request of only \$3,996.50 to the TLCB, mindful of limited available funds. The local villagers have graciously offered to provide labour free of charge for the construction efforts. The remaining funds needed to complete the project will be contributed by the villagers themselves and the school administration. We have provided detailed proposed budgets and items below to account for the \$3,996.50 being requested.

We hope that the President could consider this request if possible.
