PLUS – Optimisation of Space

In environments with multiple users, the wall track makes it easy to adjust the layout to individual user needs – without the need for building alterations or tools. All bathrooms do not need to be fully fitted, as any product on the wall track can easily be lifted off and put into another room where it is needed.
