opened. A joint project of the county and the Bureau of Indian Affairs, it is operated with an express commitment to provide care for Native American patients.



1985

UNM Truman Health Services

established to provide care for HIV-positive and LGBTQ patients.



1990

UNM Center for Development & Disability

founded as New Mexico's premier center for development and disability research, service and education.



2004

UNM Center for Native American Health

founded to serve the health and education needs of Indigenous communities and students statewide.



2016

UNM College of Population Health

founded, dedicated to training students to improve health outcomes.



2019

UNM Hospitals

recognized as a Leader in LGBTQ Health-care Equity by the Human Rights Campaign Foundation.
