Stingray Swim Team News

The warm days of summer are quickly approaching. **Looking for a way to keep your kiddos connected to their friends and stay active?** Join one of the best swim teams that Herndon has to offer. Our developmental league has a place for the beginner to the advanced swimmer, ages 5-18 years. Our coaches keep the sport fun while at the same time focus on improving stamina, strength, and form in the pool. Everyone who participates in a meet gets a ribbon and the entire team has an end-of-season party with the famous "paper plate awards," tailored to each child individually.

BECOME A STINGRAY:

All dues-paid members are invited to join the swim team. The only criterion is that your **child must be 5 years or older and able to separate from parent(s) and follow directions in a group setting.** Prior to participating in a meet, swimmer must be able to swim across the pool without assistance.

FAQ:

- **What if my child isn't quite able to make it across the pool alone or is scared to try?**

We will work with your swimmer to get them ready for the season. Our coaches are known for the extra time and care they give our new swimmers. They will also spend extra time in the water with anyone who needs it. There is no requirement to swim in a meet, so don't feel pressure, our focus is on development and fun. - **What if we are still unsure or have questions?**

We are happy to let your child join a few practices at the start of season, please come to the open house on May 2 to discuss your try-on options.
