---

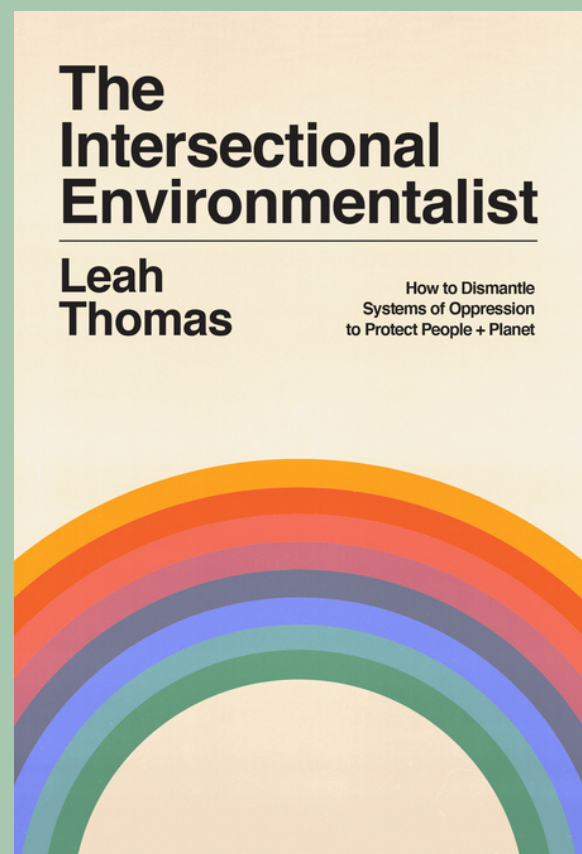
