Report of SHRWD Meetings of August 13, September 10 and October 15, 2019

I was not in attendance of the August 13 or September 10 SHRWD meetings but have included subjects discussed in the report below.

Wastewater Rehabilitation Project Funding

The District is still answering questions for several lending agencies.

Montgomery Hotel Project

The project has been delayed 3 months due to the upcoming closure of the I-70 and Ind. Road 3 exits for repairs.

Other

Dungan installed a new air conditioning unit for the laboratory.

The District GIS system program is about 2/3 complete.

The District has signed with Bailey Special Risks, Inc. for cyber insurance.

The District had two new connections in September.

Four District employees and/or board members will be attending the Alliance Fall Conference later in October.
