Old Business:

Kelly Ankrom request council to set the guidelines for the property at 402 North St., Lewisville, IN since the re-zoning for said property has been established. Reviewing the property size and surrounding properties it was said: **NO ROOSTERS**, up to 15 adult chickens/turkey. Justin Thompson at this time asked how the fines/fees, and attorney fees would be handled. Ms. Ankrom expressed that she had tried to work with the Clerk Treasure Office to avoid any extra expense to the town or herself. Ms. Ankrom stated that fees became an issue due to not getting respect from the Clerk's office. Appointments were not kept, messages not returned. The Deputy Utility Clerk, Tammy Matney is in the office in the evenings stated there had been times Ms. Ankrom would stop by the office with copies and ask the information be passed onto the clerk and council. Justin Thompson requested this situation be tabled until Larry Smith could be at the next meeting.

Ms. Ankrom also informed the board that the gravel they'd requested to be put down on the end of North St. was basically dumped and no one came back to smooth the gravel. Three years ago Ms. Ankrom had gravel hauled in and paid for herself. Make known this is a town street.

New Business:

Discussion of hiring Ron Walker as contract labor to provide law enforcement to the Town of Lewisville. There were different items discussed involving this position.

At the December 13, 2018 meeting the contract will be available for signature with the final guidelines for this contract labor position.

Council requested Gregg Morelock town attorney if he'd prepare a Resolution for transferring of funds for this position and the 20⁰⁹ Charger Police car.

Council approved the signing of the Big B contract for 1 year with (2) 1-year extensions.

Question ask by Tammy Matney, does the town need to post speed limit signs.

Council request Nate Neal to follow up with pricing to present at the December 13, 2018 meeting.

There were no questions or comments so,


Justin Thompson motioned the meeting be adjourned, Richard Craig seconded.
