STAFF COMMUNICATION:

Fire dept. Chief Dylan Altman gave a report on the month's activity. The Fire Dept would like to use the Lewisville Park for a "Back to School Bash" either the 2 or 3 weeks of August.

Richard Craig made a motion to approve the fire dept. using the park for the "Back to School Bash". Motion passed 2-0

Two of the down spouts at the skating rink need repaired. Richard will let Waylon know so he can repair them.

Nancy is going to help the fire dept. with the "Back to School Bash" and have the skating rink open at the same time.

Melissa Highday came from Henry County Solid Waste Management District, discussion with the Town Council setting a Public Recycling container in Lewisville. This issue is tabled.

Henry County Humane Society Animal Shelter present 2023 contract. This was tabled.

Justin Thompson gave a report on BIL grant for 2023. This grant can be used for water and is a no matching grant. The first steps is to hire an engineer and put together a scope of work. The Council will need to decide asap what they are wanting to do.

The current Water Grant update is: we are still waiting on pricing for the final work so we can finish. We will be contacting Gary Ladd so we can get this finished.

Richard Craig made a motion to leave the Trash rate @ \$14.00 per house hold per month. Motion passed 2-0.

Waylon Thompson is to get a quote on the repair of the Hydrant at the Water Tower and then the Clerk will contact Mr. & Mrs. Freidenburg. (they have hit the hydrant and are willing to pay for repairs).

Jerry Rector and Richard Craig are requesting the old brick that was taken up from the sidewalk on S First St. this was tabled. 2-0.

David Deal brought pictures of his property and where he believes the town easement. There was no comment from the Council. The court date is for July 27 to discuss this issue.


No further business Richard Craig made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed 2-0.
