At 6:30 John Newhouse, President opened the public meeting with the Pledge to the Flag.

Monica Altman made a motion to approve minutes from Town Council meetings in May 2022. Motion passed 3-0.

Monica Altman made a motion to approve June claims. Motion passed 3-0.

Monica Altman made a motion to have Waylon Thompson provide the Town Council with a monthly report of the work he and Jim Thompson do. Motion passed 3-0

Monia Altman made a to approve Ladd Engineering supplemental #1 agreement with President John Newhouse to execute the agreement with his signature. Motion passed 3-0.

CCMG – John Ellison from Keiser Consulting gave an updated report on the projects for the Town of Lewisville:

Crim and Sons has a delay because of the paving plant where they purchase asphalt, they are hoping it will be next week. They will keep us updated.

DC Construction – Downtown Project: there was discussion on the repair of the retaining wall at 103 S First.

Monica Altman made a motion to allow DC Construction to use the block the Town owns for the final repairs at 103 S First. Motion passed 3-0.

Nancy has spoke with Greoff Barber and he has decided to not use the diamond. Thompson Mowing Co. agreed to mow and weed eat the large ball diamond at no cost to the Town or the Park Comm.

On June 24th at 7:00 pm the Franklin Township Trustee and the Town of Lewisville will be honoring Nance McCullers for her 40 years of service to help keep the Lewisville park up and running, it will be held at the Lewisville Shelter House.


