
Justin gave an update on the water plant project. Justin moved to move forward with the flow meter repair or replacement. Patrick second motion passed.

Combined Report of SHRWD Meetings of February 12, March 19 and April 9, 2019

**OCRA Grant**

SHRWD was not awarded a grant for sewer work in Spiceland.

**Apprenticeship**

Four applicants have filled out paperwork for an apprenticeship the District is making available through the Alliance of Indiana Rural Water Association. Interviews will be conducted later this month.

**Hotel**

With the probable building of a Radisson Hotel near Montgomery's Steak House, SHRWD is investigating possible economical development grants for a new pump station at the SR 3 and I-70 intersection with a new pressure line to Highway US 40.

**Other**

In order to control expenses, it was decided to have District employees repair and paint the sign at the entrance to the plant.

Nancy, Jerry, Donna Tauber and Lila Mondrush attended the Alliance Spring Conference March 13-14.

New E. coli testing equipment was ordered and has arrived to meet the new IDEM requirements. It is simpler to use while being more accurate than old methods.

SHRWD hosted the Indiana Regional Sewer District's Association meeting on April 8.

SHRWD will host the Southern Indiana Operators Association meeting April 24.

Pumps have been rebuilt at Tri High improving capacity greatly.

Storm events this spring have caused the District's first ever ammonia violation in effluent.

Report of SHRWD Meetings of May 7, 2019

**Apprenticeship**

Three applicants (the fourth withdrew) were interviewed by the District Apprenticeship Committee who recommended to the Board that Thomas Pfaff be offered the position. This position will replace Jerry Libby as Plant Operator when Jerry retires in two years. The Board accepted the recommendation and offered the position to Mr. Pfaff. He has been given six days to respond.

**Wastewater Rehabilitation Project**

With the probable building of a Radisson Hotel near Montgomery's Steak House, SHRWD is investigating possible economical development grants for a new pump station at the SR 3 and I-70 intersection with a new pressure line to Highway US 40. Also included would be major improvements to Spiceland infrastructure. The Board approved initiating the application process for financial assistance from State Revolving Funds (SRF), USDA Rural Development funds and US EPA Economic Development funds with the aid of Vicki Perry with RCAP and Dan Wright of FPBH, Inc.

**Other**

The sign at the entrance to the plant has been refurbished and installed.

Spreading of sludge from the drying beds on agricultural fields will hopefully begin this week.

Tricia Haler conducted a training session on water pollution for all third graders at Tri Elementary School.
