

God Corrects Us In Dreams

He'll send you strong delusions, that instead of believing the truth that you were given, you'll do what? You'll believe the lie. And, those strong delusions are not the Word, not the Word, to make a lie out of it. God doesn't send you a delusion in the Word to make a lie out of it. What does He send then? He'll send you dreams or visions that will cause you to believe a lie.

I believe it was Ahab, in the days of old, Ahab wouldn't listen to the prophet of God, so God said, "I need to send to him, I need to send a runner to him to tell him something. I need to get his attention." And He said, "Who will go down and speak to him?" And the spirit spoke up and says, "I will." And God said, "Who are you?" And it said, "I'm a lying spirit. I'll go in the mouth of the prophets of Baal, the false prophets of Ahab, and I'll tell him." And, He said, "Go."

So all the prophets of Baal told him a lie, and when the prophet of God tried to tell him the truth, he wouldn't listen. Instead he listened to all the great numbers. He said, "The numbers is what I want, the numbers of people." So, he listened to all the prophets of Baal.

What does a prophet of Baal stand for? What does a prophet of Baal stand for? A prophet of Baal means: worship of man by man, by his own spirit. That means worship of man by the desires of man, to do men-pleasing desire, It's a worship by men-pleasing desire. So the prophets of Baal are those who are going to prophecy by men-pleasing desires. That's what a prophet of Baal is. It came from Balaam.

Balaam was the one who just couldn't be satisfied with just doing what God said to do. Instead of being a prophet of God, he just had to be a prophet of his own. And he kept asking God, "Is it O.K. if I go down and prophecy to these Israelites what I want to?"

Can I go prophecy to them for profit?" The kings of the enemies of Israel wanted him to prophecy, because they knew he was a spokesman of God. So they said, "You go down in the mountain, and you prophecy against those Israelites, and then we can go in and kill them. We'll go in and run them out. We'll take over and defeat them." So Balaam knew that he couldn't do it because God had stopped him from speaking it, and he asked God several times until he finally got his wish, and the Lord said, "Go ahead and do it." He gave it to him, just let him go ahead and do it. But when he went down and did it, every time he did, he only prophesied for the people. He prophesied them strong, instead of against them. And of course, it made great anger upon the kings of the ones of the enemy of the Israelites. So, that became the way of Balaam and the prophets of Baal. And he who is a prophet of Baal, having worship of an idol god of himself, worshipping himself, and desiring to do his own will.

Let's read what it says in the book of Job. Several places it talks about dreams and visions. And so God said He will give them strong delusions that they might not believe the truth, but they will believe the lie. What lie? The lie that is in their own heart. What kind of lie is that? Well, it depends on the person. To some people, the lie that is in their heart, is that they believe that somebody else hates them. To some people, the lie that is in their heart, is they believe that somebody else has done them wrong, and they're justified in being angry and bitter, because they haven't been paid enough, because they haven't been given the right kind of treatment. They haven't been treated the way they wanted to be, on and on. Bitterness, the root of bitterness is really the root of destruction. The root of bitterness, the root of destruction.

And, in Job, chapter 33, verse 14, and on, where "For God may speak in one way or another, yet man does not perceive it." He just doesn't perceive how God is speaking. Yet man says, "Well, if God gave me a dream, I know what it says. I can interpret. I can figure out what it was." No. He says, "For God may speak in one way or another, and yet man does not perceive what God is saying." Well, why does God tell me then, if

I can't understand what He's telling me? Whoah..., for a good purpose. Who told you that God was your servant? Who said that because God prophesied, that man had to understand it? Who said that because God wrote prophecy in the Bible that man would know about it, before it came to pass, or when it came to pass?

No, God didn't write prophecy for that. God wrote it for His own glory. He wrote His own prophecy so that He could say in the day of judgment, "See, I wrote it so that if any man would have sought Me, they would have found it, and known it, that they would have known to turn their hearts and not do the things they did." He did not write it for the benefit of men. He wrote it for His benefit. He wrote it for His own glory, so He could say, "I prophesied and I brought forth. I spoke what was coming, and I brought it forth. I spoke that there would be a Servant coming, and His name would be Jesus, and He came, and He was My Word. I put My Word in His body. He was the body of a man born on the earth, and I put My Word in Him, and you wouldn't hear Him." Even John the Baptist prophesying to the people in the book of John says that he prophesies that he speaks the word of God, and yet no one hears him. No one understands him. He didn't say "some." He didn't say "most of them." He said "no one." "For God speaks in one way or another, yet man does not perceive it." It could be in a dream. It could be in a vision. It could be in speaking from one man to another. It could be as a prophet unto a man, but He says that man doesn't perceive it. "Now God speaks in a dream, or in a vision of the night, when deep sleep falls upon men, while slumbering in their beds." While slumbering, He said while you're deep asleep, while you're really sleeping, slumbering away in your bed. "When deep sleep falls upon men," He gives them a dream or a vision in the night, "while slumbering on their beds. Then is when He opens the ears of men and seals their instructions in order to turn men from his deed, and conceal pride from men, He keeps back his soul from the pit, and his life from perishing by the sword. "...He keeps back his soul from the pit, and his life from perishing by the sword."

Then it goes on to say, "Man is chastened also with pain on his bed, and with strong pain in many of his bones, so that his life abhors bread, and his soul succulents food. His flesh wastes away at sight, and his bones stick out where once they were not seen. Yes, his soul draweth near the pit, and his life to the executioners." That's what follows to those that do not hear, nor receive the dreams of God, or the visions in the night, when He gives them instructions. He gives it in the deepness of the night when you're deeply asleep, slumbering on your bed.

So people want to argue whether all dreams are of God. I am not going to argue it. I'm just going to tell you that I've never found anything that is against that. That they're all of God. I don't want to..... that's not the topic.

What the topic is, is why does God give you the dreams in the night, or the visions. Now, a vision in the day, a vision in the day, is to be very careful for. A vision in the day, you are to be very careful for. For many visions that are seen, are mental visions, and they are brought about by the strong mind of man, believing, or hoping to see what he wants to see, and he then is given deception. That is when the great deception is given you. It is the allowing of the devil to give you a vision of what you desire to hear. He gives you a deceptive vision of what you want to believe. He causes you to believe the lie that you wanted to believe.

For instance, you wanted to believe that somebody was harsh on you, or that somebody was doing you wrong, when in effect, you were the one doing them wrong, because you had failed to repent, and you had failed to get right with them. So, in the vision, you would be seeing them as doing you wrong. It is very deceptive. That isn't saying that all visions in the day are dangerous. I said that you needed to have great care exercised. You should take everything you receive - dream, vision in the day, vision in the night, all instructions that you receive audibly, or from another, and you should analyze this: "Is God talking to me? Is it my problem?" You should take it first and say, "Lord, it's me that is guilty." If you have a dream that says that so-and-so did

this to you, or that you saw someone else in the dream, as being the wrong person, and you saw them doing a sin, or a wrong that you didn't like, that you hated, and particularly if in the dream you had great anger and great hate, you can surmise, for almost a certainty, that God is telling you, THAT'S YOU! THAT'S YOU!!" And He's showing you a parallel, because that person that He used to show you is one 6 whom you would judge unrighteously and ungodly. And the one sin that God will not condone, nor will He look at lightly is the spirit of JUDGE, or JUDGING, for that was the spirit of Dan. Dan judged his brother and his sister. Dan judged his brother, the same as Cain judged his.

Cain judged his brother because they both came to make offerings to God, and one had the right offering, and one had the wrong offering. One's heart was desirous of serving God, and one's heart was desirous of serving himself. And when God accepted the offering of Able, Cain became angry, and he began to throw his fist, and he began to throw himself down, because he wanted God to also honor his offering, which was from an ungodly heart, wasn't covered by blood. It wasn't done with the blood of sacrifice. It wasn't acceptable because, it was not because he had love for God, it was because he had love for self.

And so, his anger began to be kindled, and he judged his brother. He judged his brother as reason to kill him. He judged him needing to be killed, because he judged his brother as being, receiving something that he didn't.

It's the same way with Dan, the tribe of Dan. And in the back, in the book of Revelations, you'll find two tribes missing, when the ones that are sealed for God are made. Two tribes are missing: the one is Ephraim, and the one is Dan.

Now, Ephraim is missing, because Ephraim turned to idols. Ephraim stands for the United States, by the way. It also stands for a tribe of a type of people that turned to idols, idol gods in their heart, worship of self, worship of their own glory, and worship of their own greatness. And it does stand for the U.S.A., too. And, Dan stands for those

who judged their brother.

Now, usually a judge in the long run, will turn and say, "Oh, well, I judged him because of this or that. But, your really, your judgment against that brother, or against that person, or against that wife or husband, is always, always, based upon your own iniquity. You cannot judge unrighteously, if you have a righteous heart. If you have a righteous heart, and a righteous spirit, then you cannot judge unrighteously, because you will be judging by the spirit and by the word of God. But, if you have iniquity in your heart, then your judgment is based upon that iniquity in your heart. It's looking through your eyes, as through a window of your own house. And if your window has images on it, and has dirt, and it has false figures on it, when you look out, you will see your neighbor as it looks in your own window. This is exactly what happens when you falsely judge by a wicked heart that has iniquity in it. You'll look through it and you'll see it. And, you'll see your neighbor, or your brother as yourself, and you'll judge them as being the wrong one instead of knowing that it was you that was the guilty one. For if you polish up your windows and clean them off, in other words, if you get the iniquity out of your heart, and out of your eyes, you won't be able to see it in the neighbor. All of a sudden, it will all cleanse itself.

How is this done? When the moment you begin to repent, and say, "Lord, it's not them that's wrong, it's me. Lord, it's not them that's the sin, it's me! I'm the one who lied. I'm the one who cheated. I'm the one who is deceptive. I'm the one who turned the wrong way. I'm the one who didn't want to be found in the unrighteousness I had in my heart."

That, again, goes back to the same thing we talked about earlier in the book of John, chapter 3, verses 19, 20, and 21: "And this is the condemnation, that the light...", or the truth, the understanding of the Word, "...has come into the world, and that men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil." In other words, they didn't want to be found with this evil in their heart, this bitterness, this hatred, this judgment

spirit that they have down inside, the ungodly, the unjust, the unrighteous judgment that is in their heart.

Who is the unrighteous judge? Lucifer. For, Jesus, the Spirit of Christ, the Spirit of Truth, is the Righteous Judge. He judges not by man, He judges not by His own heart, but He judges by the Word of God, allowing the word of God to be the judge up over the man to whom you speak it to. He can speak to that man and walk away, retaining nothing, meaning nothing to him, because he speaks with righteous judgment, and the righteous judgment is found in the word that he speaks. But, unto the man who he speaks to, it cuts him to the quick. It cuts his heart apart. But to the man who judges with unrighteous judgment, he does it because of anger, because you've done something against me. "I don't like you. I don't like you. I don't like who you are. I don't like you." And so, he judges from his heart with evil inside, doing it out of the anger of his heart, because of his own personal self, and his own personal pride, defensive mechanism. He judges unrighteously. And, usually, the one that's like that says, "Don't judge me. Who made you my judge? How do you judge me? You can't judge me. You're no better than I am." That's the unrighteous judge speaking back to you. That's the spirit of the unrighteous judge. That's the unholy one that is speaking.

"But these men loved darkness rather than light because their deeds were evil." And he says in verse 20, "For everyone practicing evil hates the light, and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed." He says everyone who has got hidden sin within him, doing that which is sinful, and that which is iniquity, that which is deceitful, that which is wrong down inside, he hates the light. He hates to be found out. He wants to live in deception. He wants to live in darkness. He wants to live in a lie. So, because "his deeds are evil," they are a lie against the truth. They are a lie against what they should be. Though the deed itself may not be evil, the intent of it is evil, and the reason for doing it is evil, and the lies associated with it may be evil.

A car is not evil. But, if you have a lust for it in your heart, and you go about getting it

is evil. Having fun may not be evil, but if you do it because you want to have fun for your physical body, then it becomes a lust of the physical body, and then it becomes a pleasure of the self, and then it becomes a sin. So anyone who practices evil, hates the light. He hates the truth, because he didn't want to be exposed. And that means he will fight like a wild dog, lest his deeds should be exposed.

"But he who does the truth, comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen that they have been done in God. He who does the truth, "comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen that they have been in God."

How does this all fit in with what I just read to you in the book of Job, chapter 33, of dreams? God gives you dreams in the night to tell you what is wrong with you that is hidden from your sight. He gives them to your spirit to tell you that that is you, to tell you, that is YOU.

Now, during the initial walk with the Lord, when you're yet a child, and you're unfamiliar with the Word, and you're not yet capable of taking meat, or strong drink... When you can't take strong meat or strong drink, then you have to have the milk and water. You have to have the chewed up food. And, when you have to have that, it's because you're still as a baby, as a child. And God then gives you dreams that are visible to your understanding. He starts out giving you dreams that are very visible to your seeing, so that you can without a doubt decipher, interpret what the dream is saying to know that it's something that's in your life, such as exposing the spirit of hatred, or exposing the spirit of fornication, or exposing the spirit of lying within you, whatever it may be.

Then, as you begin to progress in your walk with the Lord, He begins to increase the depth of your dream to where He then begins to show you as a parallel of someone else. So you can look and say, "Wow, I see so-and-so. God's showing me how bad so-and-so is." No, He's not. He's showing you how bad you are. "He's showing me how bad those other people are." No, He's not. He's showing you how bad you are. He's

showing you a parallel, so that you, looking through your window, see someone else, so that you can be called the unrighteous judge, and you may be condemned to death in hell, if you don't do something about it. He is trying to save your soul from the pit.

Now, if God were to stand down and throw in front of everybody's face what was right and wrong, most people in their own pride would rise up and try to do what was right to the best of their own thinking. Would they love God? NO. They just do it because they were trying to please God and get something out of it.

God desires a people who will love Him, who will serve Him out of the love of their heart, for Him. He desires a people who will seek for Him with all their heart, that will lay their lives down to find the ways of God. That's what He seeks for, a people who would do that which is a love for Him. But most want to do it if they can figure out what to do.

So, He begins to show you the depth of your dream, and He tells you the things that you can see inside yourself if you would turn around and look in a mirror. Here again, comes in the scripture, Daniel, chapter 10, verse 12. And He said in Daniel, "From the moment that you set your heart to understand and to humble yourself before God," I have started on my way. I began to come to You. "That the words that you spoke were heard." When the moment you set your heart to understand, and to humble yourself before God. How long before that had he not been doing that? Well, the scripture didn't say that. Did it? Has it been a year, five years, or twenty year of his life before he did that? But He said that when you finally decide to set your heart to understand, and to humble yourself before God... To humble yourself before God... To humble yourself before God means, when you see these deep dreams in the night, you say, "That' me, God. That's me."

And when somebody walks by and says something to you that tells you how wrong you are, you immediately lower your head, and you say, "That is me, God. That's what I am. I am a deceiving, deceptive, lying, fool. I have played these games all my life inside. I have lied. I have cheated others. I have made others think I was something

when I was nothing. I put on a game all my life to try to make somebody think I was something, and I was a lying fool. All my life is what I was, deceived and deceptive down inside all the way.

So He gives you dreams in the night to show you what a lie you are, and what a liar you are. And as you continue to grow, He begins to make the dreams more definitive and yet deeper, and yet more complex, and all you have to do is to understand it's you. If you can understand it's you, you'll be able to decipher it. And if you think it's a dream telling you prophecy to come, it may be some of that in there too. You can file it away, because many dreams have dual meanings. One is for today, for you, and the other is to come in some time future. When you think a dream has been fulfilled, watch out, because then, you're like a fool walking in the dark without your glasses. Because when that dream that you think is fulfilled, it will come upon you again in your most inopportune time, and God would have said, "If you would have humbled yourself before Me that day, I would have caused it to be easy. I would have caused it to come to pass with rightness. But, since you didn't, it came upon you in the dark of the night."

When He gives you a dream, you must commit it to your spirit. You may understand them, and you may not later on. There may not be an interpretation given, but God knows it. And, that's all that is needed. If you commit it to your spirit, it will be brought forth so that your spirit will walk righteously before God, if you will humble yourself before Him, and if you will set your heart to understand.

Understand what? You set your heart to understand the ways of God. You set your heart to understand, UNDERSTAND the ways of God. YOU SET YOUR HEART TO UNDERSTAND THAT YOU ARE THE WRONG ONE. YOU are the ONE He is talking to. YOU are the one that's got the problem! Set your heart to understand that this is God's world. This is God's creation. This is God's organization. This is God's way of doing it. Set your heart to understand that YOU ARE NOT THE RULER. Set your heart to understand that HE IS GOING TO BRING THINGS TO PASS. Set your heart to

understand that, and then humble yourself before the Word of God. Get it humble. Get it very humble, instead of rising up in your bitterness and your anger, and your judgment, and your unrighteous judgment, your complaining, your whining, your murmuring, your bitching, your griping. That's what's happened to Ephraim. He has gone to idols. He has gone to the idols. His idols are bitching, whining, complaining, griping, moaning, always unsatisfied, never complete, because he's never got God as his completeness within. He talks about God, but he has the ways of the devil. He talks about God and Jesus Christ, but does not know to live them. He lives a lie, a deception. He doesn't come to the light that his deeds may be exposed, but he remains hidden so that he cannot be seen in the darkness. And, he lives as a stranger in the midst of all. That's the way of the devil. That's the way of darkness. That's the way of a lie.

And God said, "I give you dreams in the night that you may understand your sin and know that I am trying to keep your soul from the pit." No dream has action in itself! No dream takes action in itself. All dreams are given by God, as an inspiration to man, as an understanding to keep his soul from the pit, that he may commit them to God, and he may take action as needed, when it is needed and required. And all dreams do require action! ALL, understood or not understood, they all require action.

The first thing they require is: "God I don't understand it and I don't need to. I commit it to You, and to Your Holy Spirit that He will cause me to walk without fail, without stumble, without fault, before You, Oh, God, that You will cause the mountain of the problem that is ahead of me, that's in my life, that I do not yet see, cause that mountain, Oh Lord, to be knocked down, and to be made as a plain before You. Cause it to be made smooth as a plain before You, Oh Lord. And cause me to know the ways of my error, that I will not sin against You, Oh God, in all the days ahead. Cause me to know the wrong that I'm doing against You, Oh God, that I now do that displeases You," and that is the way my prayer will be and is. Then, if I understand what the dream says, then I commit it, and I then get out the spirit that is in it, and iniquity, and then I ask Him

to carry me through the testing and trials, so that I'll be found strong in the day that I come into my testing, before that spirit, and before that problem, so that I will not stumble when I come to face that mountain that my problem really is inside. If it is a spirit, or a desire, or idol worship inside - not mine - but I'm saying, people who have one of materialism. They're always wanting to play games and have fun and have little toys for themselves. What a tremendous idol. It is the idol of a child, an idol that gets them in all kinds of trouble, that it must be seen and identified as a great mountain ahead of them.

So God gives you dreams to tell you what's wrong. Now does He give dreams to all people? No. When does He begin? Only when you turn to the Lord. But why wouldn't He give it ahead of time? Because it doesn't do any good. You're not going to hear it anyway. But then it is true, that there are many people in the world that He has called since they were little, and He's given them dreams, usually the same type of dream. Or, maybe the same dream over and over, and that dream in reality, is telling them how much they are wrong against God and how they are going to go to hell if they don't change. So that is giving them a warning of what they should do.

Others He doesn't give any dreams to until they receive the Baptism of the Holy Spirit and they begin then to turn their heart towards God, to seek after Him. To set your heart to understand God doesn't mean to just say, "I will. I will understand You, God." To set your heart is a big thing. You need to sit down. You need to study on it. You need to read it over and over and ponder on, "Now what does that mean? To set my heart to understand God. To set my heart to understand God. To set my heart to understand." To understand Who He is, what His way is, and that I'm not the chief. I'm not the judge. I'm not seeking after something great in this earth. "Who am I? And, Who is He?" To set my heart to understand. That's what's so necessary.

So if I don't set my heart to understand, I will always be looking at myself and saying, "I'm right, and they's wrong. I'm right and he's wrong. I'm right: they're doing me wrong,

doing me injustice." Because the devil is able to tell you injustice against everything. The devil is able to have a counterfeit for everything that is good in the Lord, everything the Lord is trying to do to get your life broken, and humbled before Him, so that He can bless you, that He can take you out of debt, take you out of your troubles, give you health. Give you health! If you're going to the hospital or you're sick, you know then that you got the devil upon you. You know then you got some real problem. If you got a big heavy overlaying because a problem of your health, you know something is wrong.

But when you set your heart to understand, understand, set - your - heart - to understand, and then you will humble yourself before God, you'll look at it and you'll begin to see, "Boy, that's God. God is in charge of everything. God is in charge 18 of everything. Everything is His. It's under His control. It's under His domain. It's under His action. He has authority over everything. He is the supreme Creator, the supreme Master. I need to repent. That's all I need to do, is to confess my deeds, and to repent. I need to read the Word, search it out, and I need to come to the light, and I need to confess my faults one to another, that they will be exposed as the deeds they are, and the darkness that they are. For when I expose my lies, by speaking them out of my mouth, and I begin to speak AGAINST myself, instead of FOR myself, then I begin to see the true light. I'll begin to see the truth of the situation.

Oh, but man doesn't want to do that. He just hates to do that, because it makes him have to say he's wrong. It makes him have to say, "I'm a lie, aren't I? A true liar." A true liar is one who lives a lie. He lives a false life that is unknown to himself and others. He doesn't even know who he is himself. That's what is a liar.

A liar is one whose life is lived in darkness. That's a liar. A true liar may speak lies out of his mouth, and he may not. He may speak what he thinks is the truth. He may think he speaks the truth of what he believes, but it's still a lie, because his life is in darkness. His life and his insides are hidden in darkness. How much does it take? Just one area. Just any one area that you practice evil. Practicing evil means practicing

a false god. Practicing worship of some idol God in your heart, in your life, desire, some secret desire, like ole Jimmy Swaggert. He had a lustful desire for pornography or kinky sex, or whatever it was. I think it was kinky sex, so he practiced that in his heart as a lie, and he was hidden. That was his idol God. And because he would not come to the light that he be exposed, he lived that lie. He lived that lie, and he practiced that lie, and he was a liar. He was living the place of a liar. He was a true liar, and that's what a true liar is, one who practices sin in his heart, and keeps it hidden from all others. That's why the scriptures say, "Ye shall know each other. Ye shall be known as you are. And those who are not known as they are, are soon exposed. And when those who are hidden in sin in the house of God, God will cause those who are hidden in sin to be removed. He will cause them to be exposed, that their deeds may be seen as evil, and they will be removed, because He knows who is the sinner. He knows who is the liar. And though He loves them just as much, they cannot receive His love or have it, because it's hidden from them. Because it's hidden in darkness. They're living a lie. They are hidden in a lie.

So, God gives them dreams in the night, in the deep sleep, in the slumber, showing them what's wrong with them. And, it confuses them, and it causes them all kinds of worries and problems, and yet they don't understand what those dreams are, nor do they need to. But, in their confusion, they won't do what is right. But, if they will commit it to their spirit and cause themselves to repent and be broken, then God will cause them to humble themselves one day, and to repent and to weep with sorrow over the wrong, and to get themselves rightened out, and see what a liar and a fake they have been, and how they've been living in lies and in darkness, in religion that they have.

Many people think they can be a practicing homosexual, as long as they go to church. "I'm a good little baptist boy, even though I'm a practicing homosexual. Doesn't make any difference. God loves homosexuals, too. So I can go down to my little Baptist church and be a homosexual." I say Baptist, because I know more Baptists that

are practicing homosexuals than are anything else. That doesn't mean all of them are. It just means some of them are. And yet, they're the ones that hate the homos more than anyone else.

They call them "homos". But the real homosexual that God hates is this: it's one who sucks on his own thoughts and his own words, believes his own lies, and lives for men. He is one who will hear a man's voice, but will not hear the voice of God. It's one who goes down to hear the voice of man, and not the voice of the woman, who is wisdom, who is the truth, who is the word, but instead they will suck on the word of a man, a preacher, or a religious man. That is a practicing homosexual that God hates.

God hates fornicators, too, in the flesh. They shouldn't do it because it's hard on their flesh, but that's not where the sin is. The sin of a fornicator is one who has been chaste to the Lord, as His bride, turns, and listens to the voice of a man, of a spirit that is not of God, a seducing spirit, and they go out and they fornicate with it in the dark, with a seducing spirit from within their own body, a spirit that seduces them from within their own body. That's fornication. That is fornication.

And, if they are married to Christ, and they have the Spirit of Christ upon them, then that is adultery. That is adultery because they committed adultery against the bridegroom. But, God gives you deep, deep sleep dreams, so that you will not have a mistake, because at that point your subconscious mind is shut off, and your outside mind is shut off, your thoughts are shut off, and you're in a sleep where you're in a twilight, an area where God can speak to you, in your spirit, and you cannot refuse it. You have to hear it. Even as much as some people hate to hear the dreams that they have. They will actually shake in a dream. God gives that dream to them and makes them hear it, makes them hear it!

And when a person is a judgmental type of person, a religious bigot, He gives them a dream about somebody else, and He shows them what somebody else has done wrong, so that they in turn will judge them. If you receive a lot of dreams about others

that you know, you begin to think, "I must be a judge." God is showing me that I am a judge of my brothers and my sisters. I come from the tribe of Dan. If you have that problem, you probably come from the tribe of Dan.

If you have idols in your heart, you come from the tribe of Ephraim. You're not yet of the right tribe. And if you have been receiving a lot of dreams in the night telling you that you're seeing others, particularly those of your family, those that you know closely, and you're seeing them as wrong against you, or in another light, a light that is unfavorable, you better start thinking, because I believe that God is telling you, for a fact, it's you He's telling are the sinner. You are the judge of, the unrighteous judge of your brother. You are the one who in your heart wants to have that kind of a situation. You are the one in your heart who wants to have bitterness, hatred, envy, jealousy, towards that brother or sister, and God is trying to save your soul from the pit, from being a judge of your brother. Because, Dan is not going to be there in the end, the tribe of Dan, the judge of his brother will be cast out.

When you've received those dreams, you need to commit them to the Lord, one hundred percent. And you need to get down and begin to repent immediately, whether you understand it or not. It doesn't make any difference.

And as you begin to progress, and you begin to do that which is right, and commit the dreams to the Lord, and you begin to grow in faith, and you begin to grow in a walk with the Lord, He then begins to take your dreams and put them in your spirit at night so that you see them while you are asleep, but when you wake up, you can't remember them, but you know that you had a dream, but you can't remember what the dream is, so then you commit it to your spirit, and if you're walking in the Spirit, by the Spirit, then He will cause you to walk through the day righteously, if you commit it, and if you're humbled, and if you set your heart to understand. If you've done all these things, then He will cause you to walk around that sin, and He will cause the sin to be made as a plain before you.

Oh, you'll see it. Oh, you may stumble into it. Oh, yes, you may have a trial, but He will be your strength during that trial, if you have grown in faith to be able to commit your dreams to the Lord, and allow Him to do the walking and the talking for you. But if you haven't, then you won't be able to do this. But when you have come into the faith, and stronger, He will still continue to give you dreams, in the night continuously, so that He will cause your spirit to be purged and washed, and cleansed, day by day, as you walk and speak in the Lord, in the Spirit.

But if you are still receiving your dreams where they are still visible, you want to see why, after this period of time, you have to still have visible dreams. Oh, He'll give you some, but if they are all that way, then I would question why you have not yet strengthened yourself. But if they are being hidden in your spirit, part of the time, then that means that your strength is there. You should be able to walk by the Spirit. If all of them are hidden in your spirit, then you are probably talking face to face with the Spirit, by the Spirit, throughout the day, and God is hiding your dreams in you, and you are then walking by the Spirit, and He is causing those problems to come before you, and you're able to walk through them without sin or fault, and you'll be able to see and perfect as you go through each day.

Your soul and your heart and your body is being perfected, your heart before God, is being perfected in the likeness of the Lord, by the Spirit from the instructions of the dreams throughout the night. It's just like God sealed into you these instructions in the night so that throughout the day you can walk.

I usually find that a dream that is sealed from within comes true within 24 to 48 hours, and it is never what I thought it would be. It's always on a parallel. It's always seems to be a lot different than what I thought it would be in many cases. A lot of times, after the situation happens I will then reflect back and see the dream I had in the night that I never remembered, and I will reflect back and remember, "Oh, I had a dream, and it was exactly what I just had a situation with." He was showing me ahead of time so

that I would walk through it and He would explain to me what's coming each day so that I would not be surprised when the situation occurred, because my spirit is already aware of it coming to pass. And, when He gives it this way, then He, in the Spirit, will cause us to walk and give us strength. He SEALS our instructions within us. But, if you're receiving dreams, and you're trying to figure out what those dreams are, and it's causing you confusion, or doubt, or fear, then you know then that you got rebellion in you. You're rebelling inside trying to figure out what it is, and you know you got a sin inside, because you know you're not willing to expose it.

Instead of turning your eyes to the side, and saying, "Lord, I need to set my heart to understand, and I do." And when I set my heart to understand that I'm wrong and God is right, then He will begin to expose my sin. He will begin to expose it, according to what I can stand, day by day. He doesn't always, normally expose your sin all at one time, because you probably couldn't stand it if He did. But what He does, God will begin to open it up to where you can see a little light on it. You can begin to see that there's something down inside that's not yet, quite perfect with you, with God. You're either are ashamed to come in His presence and praise Him, or you find yourself beginning to run from Him. Instead of coming to God, you're going out and prophesying to others and trying to read the Word to them, or you're out trying to raise a ruckus. Or you're trying to be a smart-head. Or, you're trying to justify yourself, on and on, instead of coming to the Lord and saying, "Lord, I know that I'm guilty. I know that I'm a wrong man. I know that I'm doing wrong. I'm living in sin, and I don't want to expose it, God, because I'm ashamed of it. Because of my shame, I don't want to expose it. I don't want anyone else to see it. I don't want to be seen for my unrighteousness. I don't want to come to the light that I might be saved, that I might have the truth in my heart. I don't want to give up my evil, Oh God, because I might be a shameful person. I don't want somebody laughing at me, or thinking evilly of me, because that's what I would do to others," he says. "Instead of coming to the light, then I will stay hidden in the darkness, so that I

can't be seen." And, a man who does that loves darkness. He loves darkness, and he hates the light. In other words, he hates the truth. That is a man that is a hater of the truth. He speaks against the truth, mouths against the truth. He bad mouths things against the truth, and he justifies himself with his own lies and his own deceit, until he finally believes the lie, instead of the truth that's he's been told that he might be damned, as it says in II Thessalonians, second chapter. It's exactly what he does. He begins to believe his own lie, and he justifies himself with his own lie, to where he literally believes that lie is a fact in his own life. He then, disregards God's dreams, he disregards God's instructions, he disregards His teachings and all the words that he had, and he begins to live as a religious bigot, religious nut, a religious fanatic, idiot, and he doesn't understand the way of the Word. He doesn't have any humbleness upon him, and no, no repentance is in their heart. No repentance comes out of their mouth. Its' not necessary for them to repent. They don't have anything to repent for. It's all somebody else, or "Well, God loves sinners, too." And the old justification of self comes in, and after that dreams don't do any good. And, perhaps God does give a dream after that, once in a while, He'll give them a dream, and He will show them a sin, that if they were to finally turn their heart, He's still working with them. He worked with Cain until finally He said, "Cain, I can't do anything more for you. You don't want to hear Me." And God didn't show Himself to Cain. He didn't stand in front of him and speak to him, He spoke to him in the spirit, and He sent him out from His presence. In other words, God turned His face from him, and when He did, the moment He turned His face, Cain knew that. Because the moment He turned His face, Cain knew then that something had happened tremendously bad, because then heaviness came upon him. Sin came upon him. Wickedness came upon him. Hatred came upon him. Remorse came upon him. Darkness came upon him. And, when darkness comes upon you, you can't speak the truth. You'll speak a lie. You'll take the same truth that you knew, and you'll turn it around and you'll make a lie out of it. You'll turn around and say, "I don't believe that

this has really happened. I don't believe these words. Well, it might not be this way. Well, we don't have to do it this way." It's always a doubt, a question mark, or a lie. That's making a lie out of the truth.

And God said, "I give you dreams in the night, in your deep sleep, when you slumber upon your bed, so that you will not, NOT miss Me. So that I will have told you the way to go, that in your day of judgment, they will be used against you."

You say, "Well, why does God give dreams if they're not going to turn?" Because there's a day of judgment coming, and He wants to be... And a righteous judge has all, allll necessary things against the evil one. They cannot have a word to say. They will look at their own self, and they will be known in their own heart that I have been given instructions and I have failed to heed them. I knew the way of the light, but I refused to come. I just would not turn. I had so much bitterness in me, that I wanted to be bitter, and judge others. I wanted to bitch moan and gripe, and complain and whine all the time, and I would not turn my head and hear the truth. I would not come, and I loved darkness more than I could stand the light, and that's exactly what will happen to them. They will be lost in that day, because those that have that will certainly have no place with light - NO place in the Kingdom of God.

So God gives you dreams that you might be turned and save your soul from the pit. He might turn man from the pit and conceal his pride from him. He might bring him around and conceal his pride from him. He keeps back his soul from the pit, and his life from perishing by the sword.

"He gives him the deep dreams in order to turn man from his deed." TURN his head! He said, "TURN AND LIVE! TURN! REPENT! CONFESS! Get rid of that bitterness inside, that unholiness inside you. Even though you think you're right, you're not. You're a lie. Even though you think you're doing right, you're a lie! TURN! Don't die! Don't turn your soul unto the pit!" "...and conceals the pride from man, and keeps back his soul from the pit, and his life from perishing by the sword." The sword is the word of

God that strikes him to death. The sword is that word, that sharp word that strikes him to death, cuts his heart to the quick, and just chews him to pieces, because he wants to live a lie. He won't hear the truth.

So, if you have visions during the day, be very cautious. I would question them. I would look at them very carefully. And, boy, if it is a lie, it will be so heavy upon you, you can't get rid of it. If it is a lie, you won't be able to forget it. If it is a deceiving vision, you will have so much temptation to want to believe it that you can't even stand it. Your heart just grips to want to believe it. If you have a deceiving vision, a lying vision, your heart just wants to believe it so bad, that it will believe it over a thousand other dreams that God has given you, and it will cause you to turn from the realities of the truth, because of one deceptive lying vision.

And Satan does give lying wonders and signs to deceive the unrighteous. He gives those lying wonders and signs, and deceptions so that he will take away the heart of those that are in sin, and do not hear the truth or come to the light. He gives them these visions so that they will hear it, and see it, and believe it, and it will literally over take them. They will believe it so strongly that they cannot get around to understanding that that's a lie. And they won't even tell people. Usually when they have a vision like that, they won't tell you the full vision, because it is so deceptive. They know it's a lie. Their spirit knows it's a lie, and they won't tell you the true vision, because if they did, they know that it would be exposed for the lie that it is. And, the demon, and the liar inside, keeps it from coming out of you, so that it won't be heard, so that you can't refute it on them. And they will take that vision, and they will live that damn lie until their own death. It's the most deceptive thing I've ever seen, but they will believe that lie. And why? Because God said, "I will give them that deception, and they will believe the lie, but they won't believe the truth that I've given them in the dreams. They will renounce it, the truth for one stupid foolish lie, or two or three that they know doesn't make sense. But it suits their heart because it matches their evil in their own heart. It matches the evil in

their own desires of their own heart. It matches that evil, to where that's what they wanted to do to begin with. They wanted to believe that against someone, or they wanted to bring that against someone, that accusation. They wanted to have that accusation, and that demon in their heart, brings forth that vision in the day time hours, to make them believe that and to see it and to hear it. Because, when they're praying to God, they still have the sin upon them, and the lie. The iniquity is upon them, and they're praying in sin. And while they're praying in sin, their god answers them, and it's not the God of Heaven. It is the god of their own heart. It is the god of bitterness, the god of hatefulness, the god of judgment. The god of judgment invariably will show you someone else in a bad light that is your brother or sister.

I can't remember when I've had a dream with somebody in it that I know, recently. I don't know how long it's been - a year, two, three, since I've had someone in it that I really knew in that dream. I had some I thought was so-and-so, but I can't remember when I've had somebody in it that was somebody that I knew.

But I know others that have had people in it that they knew every dream they had. They're always dreaming about their brothers and sisters, and it's always wrong about them. They will always see them in a wrong light, in a bitter light, a tainted light. They will always have something that they can go to them and judge them for. They always have an evil that they can pass on to their brothers and sisters of their dream, and their reason is that they're giving judgment as their spirit that they have in their heart. They're being shown that they have bitterness, evil, judging spirit within them, and that they're being told this, that God is trying to save their souls back from the pit, and turn them from their wicked deeds, that they may come to the light, and that their evil deeds may be exposed, that they may be seen for what they are, that a man can turn his heart and live for the Lord, and live for the truth, and live for the word of God, and become a God-fearing man, a God-loving man.

When you begin to see your brothers and sisters in a perfect light in your dreams,

you know then that God is telling you if you ever should have that, that you're then looking through the right window pane.

But if you have visions in the day, then you're nigh unto having troubles, because when you begin to have those, particularly when they're coming when you're praying, watch out who you're praying to, because you may be praying with bitterness and evil in your heart, and you know it, but you refuse to get anything done about it. You may have a judgmental heart, a bitter heart, an evil heart, or you may have a heart that is evil, that you have taken, instead of the heart of God, or the heart of truth, you have an evil, wicked, bitter heart inside you that you have either claimed or put in yourself, or that you have made upon yourself, and in doing so, that is the heart that is speaking to you. And out of that heart, receives signs and wonders, and miracles, and what you will see is, you will see the visions of your mental mind, visions of judgment, visions of bitterness, visions of wrongness, visions of evil, until you judge your brother, or your sister, unto your own sin. Judge them for your own sin, that you have for your own judgment, for your own wrongs.

But God said, "I give you dreams in the deep sleep of the night that you may repent and turn from your wicked deeds, and confess, and cause My ways to be your ways, to turn you from your wicked deeds."

But, when you have visions in the day, they may be from God, but I'd sure want to tell the whole vision to several people, and to see what their reaction is, particularly to someone whose anointed, someone's whose anointed to hear it, and someone whose impartial. I would also go to the one whom, maybe, you had it against, and I would say, "I don't know what God's telling me. It must be my heart that's wicked and evil." No, I don't think I would go to the one who was in the vision. I think I would go to someone else, because if you went to that person, you begin to tell them, and the moment you begin to tell them, your anger starts to rise up, you know then what's wrong then, don't you. You know then that that's truly what it is. If you have your bitterness or your anger

rises up, you know then that that is your sin. You know then that that's what God is telling you. That sin is you, and it's in you, and He's trying to save your soul from the pit. And when you get it out of you, you won't see it in anyone else. It won't even be 34 existent. Because that what you think exists doesn't even exist. It is a lie. It is idol god within yourself, and it is a lie.

What I'm trying to show you is, that deep dreams, in a deep sleep, are from God, and they tell you the ways that God wants you to go. You do not need to understand them. Many of them you will not understand. Some of them are bloody. Some of them are bloody, because God doesn't pay any attention. He is trying to show you the bloodiness, maybe, of your life, or of many other things. Blood stands for life. You don't have any idea what it means. You don't need to know. Commit it to your spirit and let Him begin to reveal it to you.

And, if you turn your head to understand, and you put your heart on God, begin to read the word, listen to all that's speaking to you, pray, and get rid of the sin and iniquity that's within you, - and if you know that you got bitterness, judgment, hatred, and unrighteousness in you, then you better get rid of it, because you know then, you're not praying to the God of Heaven. You're going to be praying to another god, and you're going to hear from that other god, and he's going to give you visions in the day time, or he's going to give you dreams while you're not in a sleep. He's going to give you dreams while you're in twilight. He's going to give you dreams in your subconscious mind. You hearing me now?! And those are either nightmares, or they're real panic dreams. They'll cause you panic. They'll cause you to be...oh man, you'll just go panic. You'll just go crazy with them, because you'll have to believe them. It's like a forcing upon you. It's like someone got you in a vice, and squeeze you to make you believe it, make you do it. You just got to go do it. **YOU JUST GOT TO GO EXERCISE THAT DREAM OR THAT VISION.** You just GOT to go put it in effect, because it's squeezed like a vice with you, because **THAT** is the devil giving it to you.

When God gives you a dream or a vision, it's in a nature that you can wait. It's in a nature that you can wait. You can see it. It may disturb you and it may hurt you, and you may be tremendously confused and disturbed, but He will cause you to wait, until you're ready to receive it.

But, when you get it from the devil, it's always going to show you somebody you can go out and hammer upon the head, somebody you can go out and condemn for your iniquity, your sin. If you have unrighteous judgment, bitterness, and hatred, griping and moaning, complaining and whining, down within you, like the children of Israel in the desert or like people today do, like Ephraim does, filled with idols, you have no place with God and neither will you inherit the Kingdom of God with that kind of nature upon you. You cannot, and you need to repent, deeply, sorely repent, and turn your head, and get away from that iniquity. **TURN** from you sins, and **LIVE!**
