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## **SBL Board Member Role Description (Voluntary Role)**

- Job Title:** SBL Board Member (General)
- Purpose of Job:** To work with the rest of the Board of Trustees to further the aims and objectives of SBL.
- Responsible to:** The board of trustees (collectively)
- Based at:** Remote
- Length of Post:** 3 years (from the date of appointment)

SBL is looking to expand its award winning board of trustees to allow the organisation to take on bigger challenges in growing the game of Box Lacrosse. The right person for this role will be someone who wants to take an active role in the grassroots development of sport, from strategy to delivery. Self-motivation and strong collaborative skills are crucial. **Non-Lacrosse players are encouraged to apply.**

SBL's board is currently responsible for all strategic and operational aspects of the organisation. To manage the workload, all board members work laterally to achieve results, with no fixed hierarchy. As such, incoming members must be able to adapt to various different tasks across the spectrum of work in the organisation, and be willing to lead on areas as required.

A specialised knowledge and/or background in: legal practice, accounting, graphic design or partnership management would be desirable, but not required.

Experience of working in a sport or business development environment would be desirable but not required.

Applicants currently active participation in the Women's field game (as a coach, player or administrator) are especially encouraged to apply.

This is a **VOLUNTARY** position, however reasonable travel expenses will be reimbursed when carrying out organisational activities.

## **Duties:**

Duties for this role are broad and specifics **will differ based off of the strengths of the successful candidate**. Broadly, duties will include:

- Attend SBL board meetings and help guide SBL's strategic direction.
- Attend weekend sessions (frequency and dates to be agreed with the other board members).
- Actively contribute to SBL's agile working culture, contributing to ongoing work across the organization as need arises.
- Apply specialist knowledge to improve the offering and processes of SBL.
- Positively contribute to the name, culture and impact of SBL
