


ABOUT THE EXPEDITION I WAS A STREET OF THE EXPEDITION ABOUT THE EXPEDITION

OVERVIEW

Yunam Peak at 6111 M is a stunning trekkable peak located in the Lahaul district of Himachal Pradesh near the famous Baralacha La Pass. Though it is less frequently climbed, Yunam Peak is a great alternative to the likes of Stok Kangri and Kang Yatse 2 in Ladakh. The summit offers fantastic views of the C.B. Range and the Mulkilla Range with views stretching as far as Zanskar. However, this trek to Yunam Peak is difficult and is meant for experienced trekkers only due to the high altitude gain and bone-chilling winds as you make your way up to the summit across moraines and scree. The Yunam Peak Expedition is a great choice for aspiring mountaineers who wish to summit a peak that is not as crowded like Stok Kangri. The July to September are the best months to undertake the Yunam Peak Expedition. Stay on this page for more details on the Yunam Peak Expedition.

Day 01: Arrival and reporting at manali.

Day 02: Manali to Jispa 63 Km - 3 hours -stay in Camp

Day 03: Jispa to Bharatpur base camp (4700 m) via Barlacha

Day 04: Acclimatization at Bharatpur base camp

Day 05: Start Climbing to summit camp

Day06: Climbing toward Summit and back to summit camp

Day07: Summit camp to Bharatpur base camp(3 hours) and

Drive back to Manali – 200 Km – 6/7 hours. Stay in hotel



FULL ITINERARY

Day 1. Arrival and Manali (Briefing about Expedition

We will wait for you at the Manali Bus Stop, from where we will move to your hotel. In the evening all members will introduce with each other and at last briefing about the Expedition.

Day 2 Drive Manali To Jispa.

Today we will drive to Jispa on the stunning Leh-Manali highway across high altitude villages via Atal tannel, Tandi (confluence of Bhaga and Chandra river) Sisu village (temple of Raja Ghepan). We will drive along the Bhaga river and reach Jispa. Body acclimatization at jispa. Overnight in hotel/tents.

Altitude: 10,800 ft.

Duration: 5 hours, 92 kms

Day 3 Drive Jispa to Bharatpur base camp.

we get our move on by 9 in the morning. Today we will drive to Bharatpur which is going to be our base for the Yunam Peak expedition via Deepak Tal, Suraj Tal and the famous Baralacha La Pass. Overnight in tents at Bharatpur.

Altitude: 14,760 ft.

Duration: 5-6 hours, 90 km

FULL ITINERARY

Day 4. Acclimatization and load ferry at Bharatpur base camp

Today we will spend a day at Bharatpur Base Camp. Rest and active acclimatisation day, height gain and back. 4/5 hours. You have almost reached an altitude of 4600m from sea level. It is quite high and you will start feeling some changes in your body as well. Some trekkers might feel tiredness, nausea, headaches, or loss of appetite.

Altitude: 14760 ft.

Day 5. Bharatpur base camp to summit camp

Today Today we trek to the base camp of Yunam Peak that is located near a small lake. Today's trek will take you across moraine with a gradual and eventually a steep ascent. There will be several stream crossings until you reach the summit camp. Overnight in camps.

Altitude: 17100 ft.

Duration: 4,5 hours trek

Level: Difficult



FULL ITINERARY

Day 6. Summit push and back to Summit camp

Finally, we have to be all set for the most-awaited and crucial day of the entire trek and hence it also gives rise to the most difficult day of the whole journey. So, brace yourself for an exhilarating day ahead. We will set out for the Summit between 1 and 2 am.

After spending some quality time at the summit, we will make our way back to the advance camp

Altitude: 13800 ft.


Duration: 9 to 10 hours trek

Distance: Both side 12 kms

Level: Moderate to Difficult

Day 7. Summit camp to Bharatpur then drive to manali.

The last day of the Expedition involves trekking back our steps to where we started - from Summit camp to Bharatpur then back to Manali. We start by early morning, so that we can reach a lower altitude as quickly as possible. After successful climb its time to celebrate that special day along with complete team.

THINGS TO CARRY

CLOTHING

- Trekking Pants
- Thermal Body warmer Upper & Lower (Base layer)
- Warm Fleece (Mid layer)
- Down Jacket (Top Layer)
- Full sleeves T-shirts (Quick Dry material)
- Pair of thick woolen socks (1 pair for every two days/of trekking)
- Undergarments / Innerwear (Quick Dry material)
- Rainwear/Poncho (Jacket & Pants)
- Pair of waterproof / snow-warm gloves
- Woolen cap
- Sun shielding Hat

FOOTWEAR

- Non-skid, deep-treaded, high-ankle trekking shoes
 - Pair of lightweight Slipper/Sandals

TREKING GEAR

- Rucksack bag with rain cover
- Day Pack Bag Recommended for treks with summit days
- Head Torch / Flashlight with spare batteries
 Sun glasses
