2 Ch 20:7 - descendants of Abraham your friend

Pr 17:17 – A friend loves at all times.

Pr 18:24 – there is a friend that sticks closer

Pr 27:6 – Wounds from a friend can be trusted.

Pr 27:10 – Do not forsake your friend and the friend of your father.

Isa 41:8 – you descendants of Abraham my friend

Mt 11:19 – a friend of tax collectors and sinners

Lk 11:8 – though he will not get up and give him the bread because he is his friend, yet because of the man’s boldness he will get up and give him as much as he needs.

John 19:12 – if you let this man go, you are no friend

James 2:23 – and he was called God’s friend.

John 15:13 – that he lay down his life for his friend

#### B. Not to be a friend

John 4:4 – “You adulterous people, don’t you know that friendship with the world is hatred toward God? Anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God.”
