### Chapter 4: Pray!

Exodus 14:10 – As Pharaoh approached, the Israelites looked up, and there were the Egyptians, marching after them. They were terrified and cried out to the Lord.

A. What type of prayers are there? And what type of prayer did the Israelites pray?

Scripture: **Gen. 35:3** – Jacob returns to Bethel “Then come, let us go up to Bethel, where I will build an altar to God, who answered me in the day of my distress and who has been with me wherever I have gone.”

**2 Sam 22:7** – David’s song of praise “In my distress I called to the Lord; I called out to my God. From his temple he heard my voice; my cry came to his ears.”

**Psalms 107:28-29** – Israelites journey through the desert “Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble, and he brought them out of their distress. “

B. What are crisis time prayers?

Scripture: **Matt 21:22** – Jesus teaches “If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer.”

**Eph 6:18** – Paul writes “And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.”

**Job 8:5-6** – Bildad to Job “But if you will look to God and plead with the Almighty, if you are pure and upright, even now he will rouse himself on your behalf and restore you to your rightful place.”

**Mark 5: 22-23** – “Then one of the synagogue rulers, named Jairus, came there. Seeing Jesus, he fell at his feet and pleaded earnestly with him,…”

**Luke 7:4** – Elders of the Jews saying “When they came to Jesus they pleaded earnestly with him,…”

**Luke 22:44** – About Jesus “He withdrew about a stone’s throw beyond them, knelt down and prayed,…….And being in anguish, he prayed more earnestly and his sweat was like drops of blood falling to the ground.”

**James 5:17** – “Elijah was a man just like us. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years.”

**Col 4:2** – “Devote yourself to prayer, being watchful and thankful.”
