Scripture: **Deut. 23:14** – “The Lord your God walks in the midst of your camp, to deliver you.”

**Psalms 34:19** – “Many are the afflictions of the righteous, But the Lord delivers him out of them all.”

**Job 5:19** – “He shall deliver you in six troubles, Yes, in seven no evil shall touch you.”

**2 Peter 2:9** - “The Lord knows how to deliver the godly out of temptations.”

**Gal. 1:4** – “Christ gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil age.”

C. God acts in providential ways.
