Chapter 10: Encircle Obstacles With Biblical Faith And Shout The Victory

Scripture: Joshua 6: – “The priests took the ark of the Lord, and the seven priests carrying seven ram’s horns marched in front of the ark of the Lord. While the ram’s horns were blowing, the armed men went in front of them, and the rear guard went behind the ark of the Lord.”

Coming Full Circle -

Jericho:

- a. 11,000 years old, almost 1,000 feet below sea level, and produces a thousand gallons of water per minute.
- b. Represents the challenge in your life that is blocking your way, hindering the accomplishment of your goal.
- c. It had a double wall on a terraced incline making it impregnable.

What Jericho are you dealing with right now?

Our Goals with His Goals:

- a. Cooperate with what God wants to accomplish.
- b. Cooperate with God’s way of accomplishing.
- c. Cooperate with God’s timing.

How can you cooperate with how God wants to use you to accomplish His goal?

Pray and declare Joshua 3:5 – “Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do amazing things among you.”

Joshua 6:15-20 – “On the seventh day, they got up at daybreak and marched around the city seven times in the same manner, except that on that day they circled the city seven times. The seventh time around, when the priests sounded the trumpet blast, Joshua commanded the people, “Shout! For the Lord has given you the city!”and at the sound of the trumpet, when the people gave a loud shout, the wall collapsed; so every man charged straight in, and they took the city.”

Accomplish Your Goal:

1. Encircle your obstacle with power, power found only in the presence of the Lord.
2. Encircle your obstacle with prayer.
3. Encircle your obstacle with the promise that God is greater than any obstacle and have the faith to put that promise to work.
4. Encircle your obstacle with perseverance and consistency.
5. Encircle your obstacle with praise.
