### **Hallowed Be Your Name**

Hallowed – to make holy, to set apart, sanctify, consecrate, dedicate.

Always start your prayer by honoring God. This sets your mind away from the gods of this world and to the one and only true God.

To fully see God and His glory, we must look for Him. How often do we look for God and His glory? And how are we to worship and glorify Him from the heart if we don’t?

### **Defiant Adoration**

The challenge is knowing God’s presence in the midst of doubt, depression, anxiety, conflict, or failure. Defying your circumstances or mindset at the time to honor God is defiant adoration.
