Each competitor is responsible for his or her competence with firearms, as this match is not designed to be a beginner’s match. You are a safety officer, responsible for your conduct, your guest’s conduct, and others within your influence. You must always follow range rules.

Spectators, please be aware of these range rules: Alcoholic beverages allowed only at the Thursday and Friday night dinners. Ear and Eye protection is mandatory within line of sight of the shooting areas. **ONLY REGISTERED SHOOTERS AND VENDORS WITH BADGES MAY WEAR FIREARMS.**

The Friday night dinner is held on the range at 5:00 pm. We will have door prizes and Side Match awards on Friday night. We do allow adult beverages at the Friday night dinner. It is BYOB. No guns, please.

The Saturday night banquet and awards dinner will be held at the Bell Buckle Banquet Hall in Bell Buckle, TN. Directions are in your shooters packet. Social hour begins at 6:00 pm. It is BYOB. Dinner begins at 6:30 pm. No guns, please.

The information presented in this handbook is subject to change. So please listen to the announcements and verbal instructions from the Match Director, Safety Officer, and Posse Marshals.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

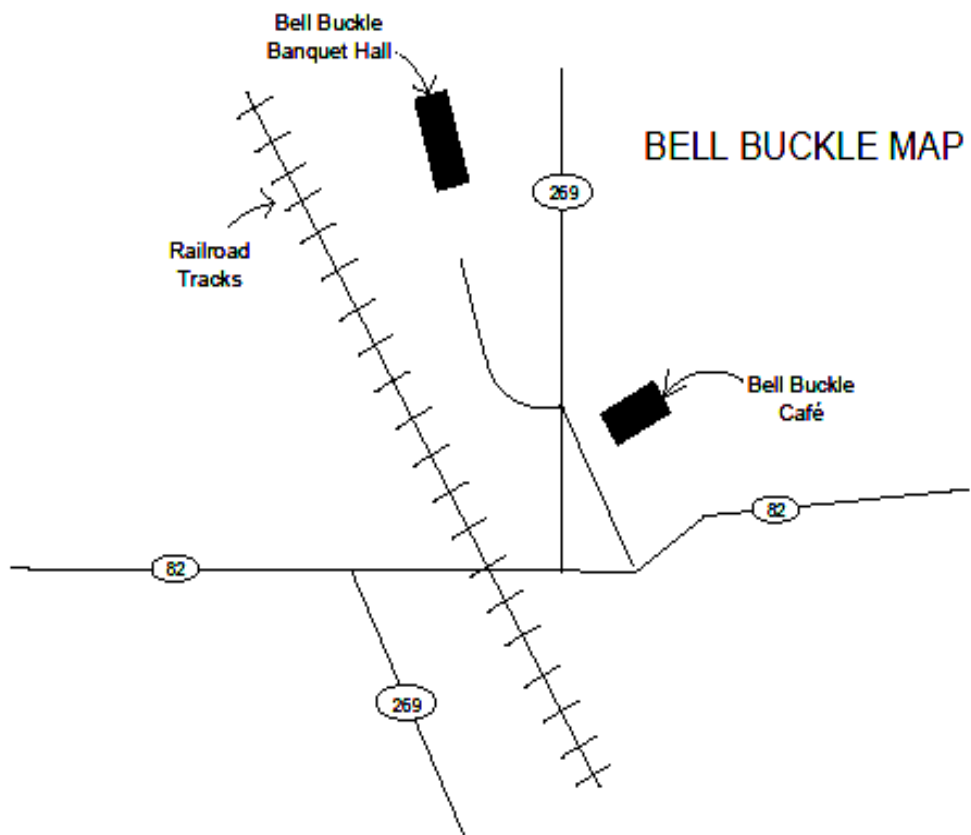
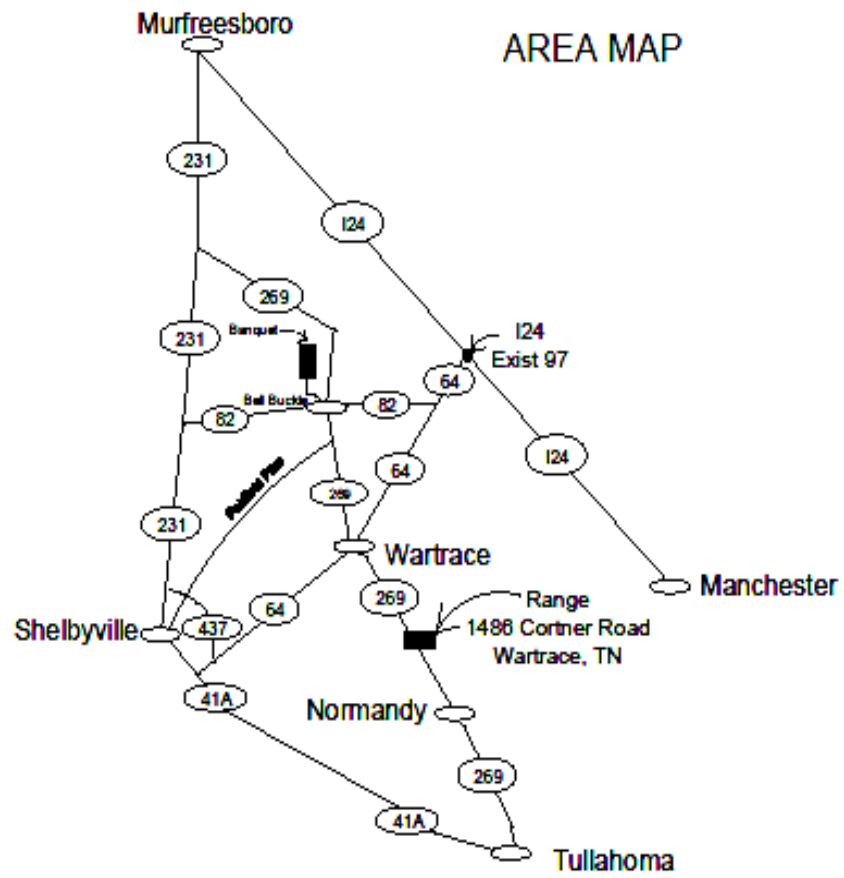
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the property.
(Allowed only during Thursday and Friday night dinner.)
- No one will be allowed to shoot if, in the judgment of the range officer, they are impaired.
- All shooters must be **SASS** members in good standing.
- Pistols must be holstered, and actions always open on long guns off the firing line.
- Firearms may only be loaded when at the loading table and on the firing line.
- All shooters and spectators must wear ear and eye protection.
- All shooters are expected to be familiar with all **SASS RULES**.
- All shooters must abide by the decision of the range officer.
- Unsafe firearm handling will not be tolerated.

OTHER IMPORTANT THINGS WE THINK YOU OUGHTA KNOW!

- The schedule assumes there are three minutes “Beep to Beep” for each shooter, including all the time of understanding the stage; checking the targets for correct alignment; getting folks loaded; etc.
- Our shooting schedule on Friday and Saturday will allow time between individual shooters for brass pickup if shooting is not delayed. Brass or shot shells beyond the firing line **CANNOT** be retrieved.
- This notice is to inform all participants and spectators that your picture may be published in the newspaper or other publications. If you have objections to this, please inform us at the check-in station. Photos remain the property of the **Wartrace Regulators** with all publication rights. So, remember to smile, you may be on camera.

Wartrace Regulator Range Rules

- This is a muzzle up action open range as soon as weapons are removed from the case and until placed back in the case.
- Eye and ear protection must be worn by shooters and spectators.
- Pistol or rifle round over the berm is a MATCH DQ at the Wartrace Regulator Range.
- All props are non-expendable. This includes staging tables.
- Shooting position is defined as being close enough to shelf or table to ground a gun by taking only one step.
- It is the owners responsibility to clean up after their pets or service animal.
- This is a **SASS** match all **SASS** rules apply.
- Total Time scoring system is used.
- Disqualified for a stage Total stage targets x 5 + 30
- Failure to complete a stage Total stage targets x 5 + 30
- Failure to shoot a stage Total stage targets x 5 + 30
- 2 stage DQ's = Match DQ
- 2 DNF's = Match DQ
- Match DQ Total match targets x 5 + 30
- Tie Breaker = Number of misses and penalties (least # places higher)

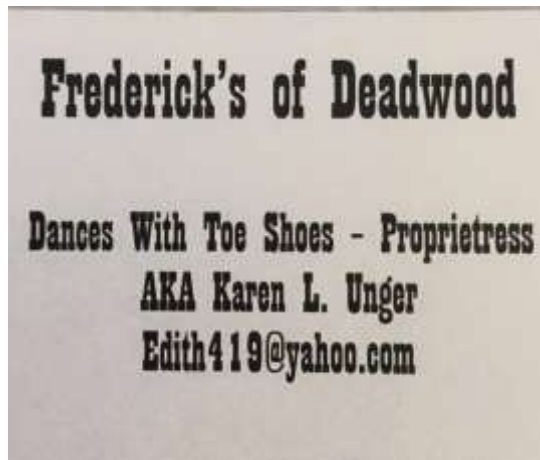

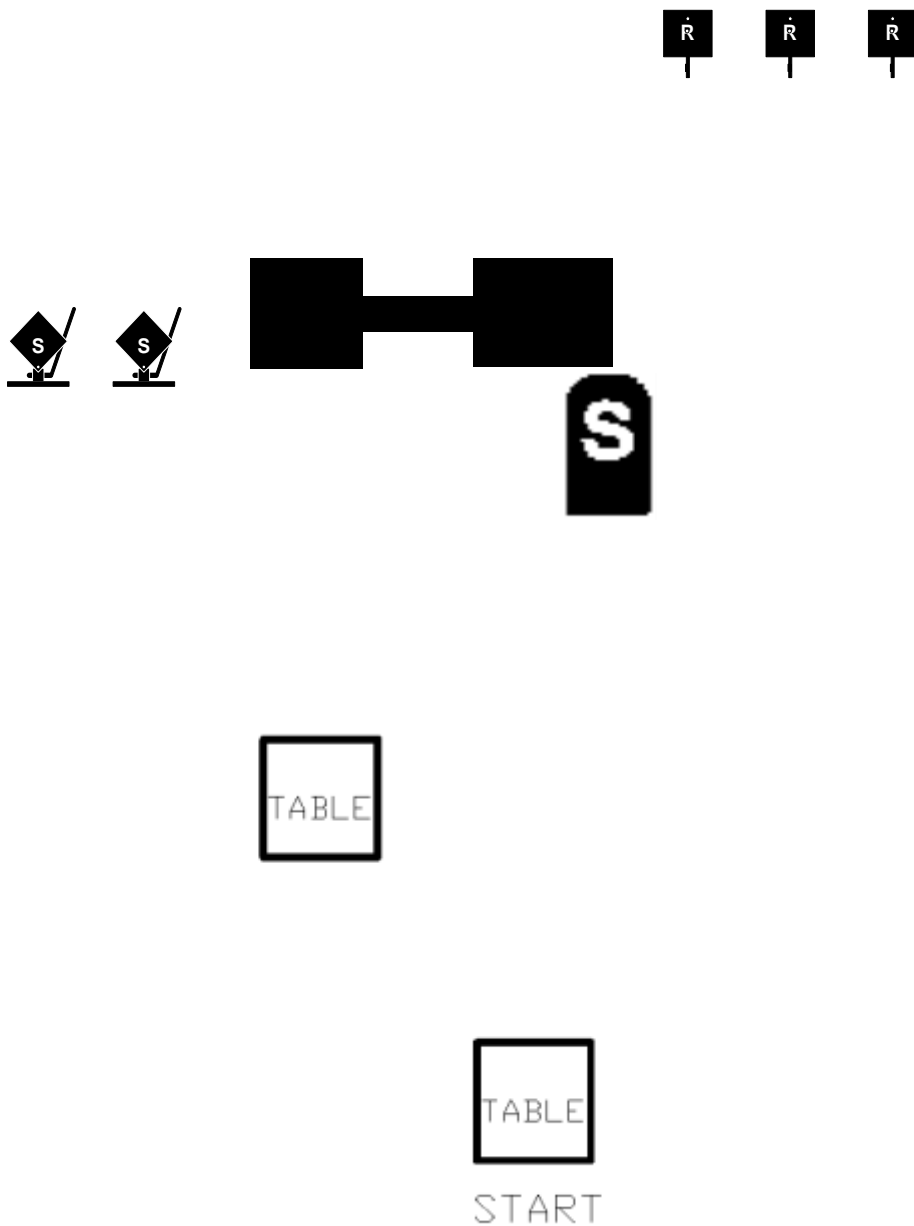

Ammo: 10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 3+ Shotgun.

BEGIN standing at shooter's discretion at right up range table. Hands not touching guns or ammo. Pistols are holstered. Rifle is staged on right up range table. Shotgun is staged on left down range table.

LINE: "I'll Never Surrender"

At the Buzzer:

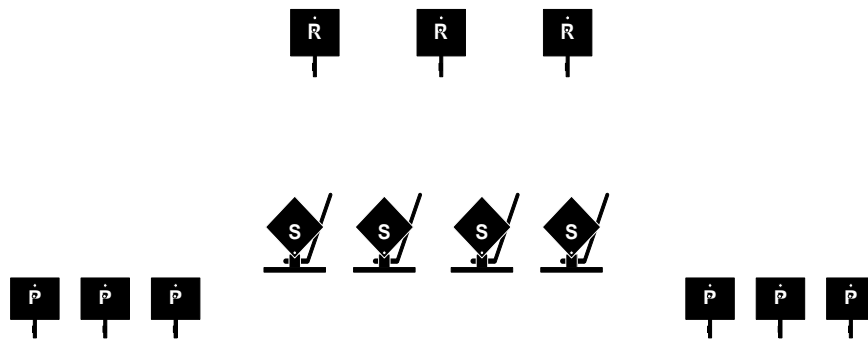
- ❖ Gun order is rifle, shotgun, pistols, shotgun.
- ❖ Rifle shot from staged location. Starting on either end rifle target engage the rifle targets with 2-6-2 sweep.
- ❖ Shotgun and pistols shot from down range table. Engage the tripper target till down then engage the wig-wag plates with pistols. Engage the black wig-wag plate with 2 rounds then engage the orange wig-wag plate with 6 rounds then engage the black wig-wag plate again with 2 rounds.
- ❖ Shotgun shot from down range table. Engage the KD's.

DEATH VALLEY

Marshall Ada Carnutt had chased the Clanton gang into Death Valley. The Clanton's were tired of running and turned to face Marshall Ada. Ada leaped from her horse with guns blazing and shouted Clanton your time is up.

Ammo: 10 Pistol, 9 Rifle, 4+ Shotgun.

BEGIN standing at shooters discretion at any table with hands touching gun or guns. Pistols are holstered. Shotgun staged on center table. Rifle staged on center table.

LINE: "Your time is up"

At The Buzzer:

- ❖ Gun order is rifle not last.
- ❖ Shotgun shot from center table. Engage the KDs.
- ❖ Rifle shot from center table. Beginning on either end target, engage the rifle targets with a 9 round Nevada sweep.
- ❖ 1st five Pistol rounds shot from either end table. Beginning on either end target engage the pistol targets with a 5 round Nevada sweep. 2nd five Pistol rounds shot from opposite end table starting on either end target engage the pistol targets with a 5 round Nevada sweep. Pistols shot from left table must be left of upright. Pistols shot from right table must be right of upright. Pistols can be split or shot back to back.

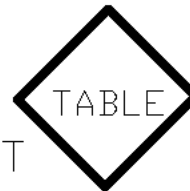

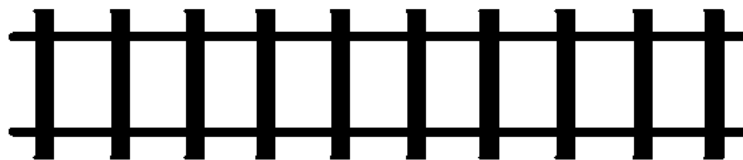

TRESTLE

Marshall Buck Garrett was riding guard for the Union Pacific Rail Road when the train came to a screeching halt on the trestle over a shallow wash. Buck leaped from the train with brass flying out of his Winchester killing Bill Dalton instantly. Marshall Buck told the remaining gang members to surrender cause he had enough brass left for all of them.

Ammo: 10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 4+ Shotgun.

BEGIN standing at shooters discretion with hands at low surrender (hands at shoulder level). Pistols are holstered. Rifle is staged on either up range table. Shotgun is staged on opposite up range table.

LINE: "I got more brass"

At the Buzzer:

- ❖ Gun order is rifle, shotgun pistols.
- ❖ Rifle shot from staged location. Engage the targets with at least 3 rounds each. No multitaps.
- ❖ Shotgun shot from staged location. Engage 2 KDs in any order then move to down range table and engage remaining KD's from the down range table. KD's are made up from down range table.
- ❖ Pistols shot from down range table. Engage the targets with at least 3 rounds each. No multitaps.

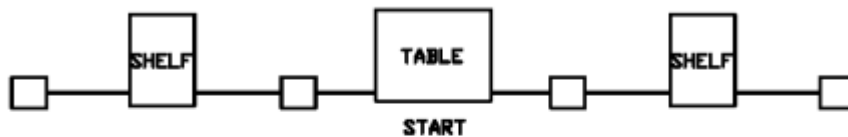
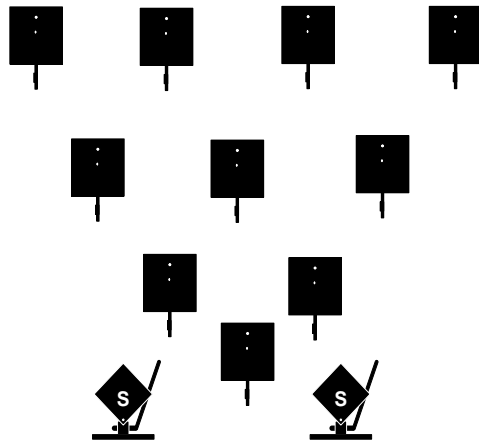

Marshall Bass Reeves stumbled onto a livery stable while on the trail of the Blevins Gang, As Bass stepped into the livery he was met with a hail of gunfire from the hillside. Bass killed or wounded all 12 of the Blevins Gang in less than a minute. Bass shouted to the wounded to surrender or choose a casket. Marion River does the best wood work.

Ammo: 10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 2+ Shotgun.

BEGIN standing at shooters discretion with arms crossed at chest level at center table. Pistols are holstered. Rifle and shotgun are staged on center table.

LINE: “Marion River makes the best”

At The Buzzer:

- ❖ Gun order is shotgun last.
- ❖ Rifle and pistols shot from the center table. With rifle and pistols engage the 4th row of targets with single taps, engage the 3rd row of targets with double taps, engage the 2nd row of targets with triple taps, engage the 1st row target with a quad tap.
- ❖ Shotgun, shot from center table. Engage the KD's in any order.

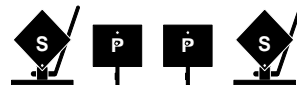
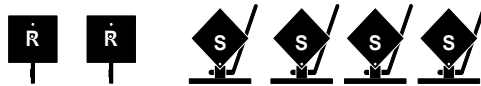

Marshall Edwin Short and a deputy were escorting Charlie Bryant to Fort Smith for trial. Charlie knew he would surely be hanged. Out of desperation Charlie grabbed the deputy's gun. When the fight was over the deputy lay dead and Charlie laid mortally wounded. Charlie asked Edwin where he learned to shoot. Marshall Short replied Ray Harvey taught me.

Ammo: 10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 6+ Shotgun.

BEGIN standing at left up range table with rifle held with both hands pointed safely down range. Pistols are holstered. Shotgun is staged on the right up range table.

LINE: "Ray Harvey taught me"

At The Buzzer:

- ❖ Gun order is rifle, pistol, shotgun.
- ❖ Rifle shot from left up range table. Starting on either target single tap R1, quad tap R2, quad tap R1, single tap R2.
- ❖ Pistols shot from right up range table. Starting on either target single tap P1, quad tap P2, quad tap P1, single tap P2.
- ❖ Shotgun shot from right up range table. Engage 2 KD's from right up range table then move to the down range table and engage the 4 KD's. KD's must be made up from original engagement location.

R1 and P1 are the end targets you put the first round on.

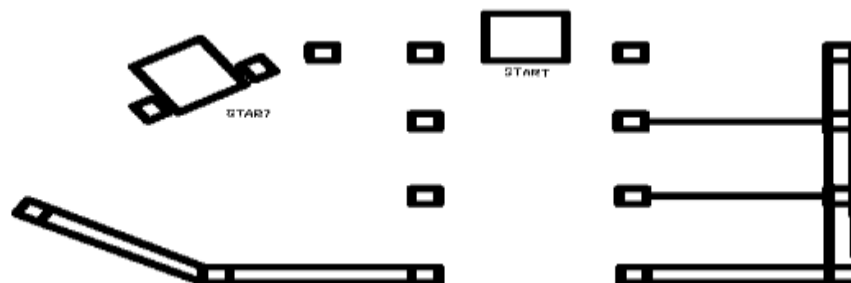
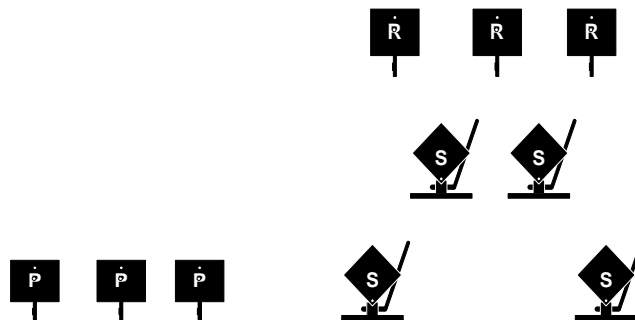

Ammo: 10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 4+ Shotgun.

BEGIN standing at shooter's discretion at left or right table with hands touching ear lobes. Pistols are holstered. Rifle and shotgun are staged on right table.

LINE: "The Colonel's bullets don't miss"

At The Buzzer:

- ❖ Gun order is rifle not last.
- ❖ Rifle shot from right table. Triple tap the center target then single tap each outside target. Repeat instruction with remaining 5 rounds.
- ❖ Shotgun shot from right table. Engage the KD's
- ❖ Pistols shot from left table. Triple tap the center target then single tap each outside target. Repeat instruction with remaining 5 rounds.

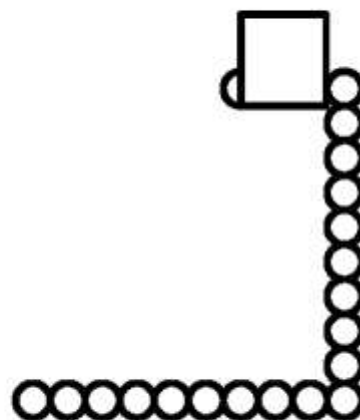
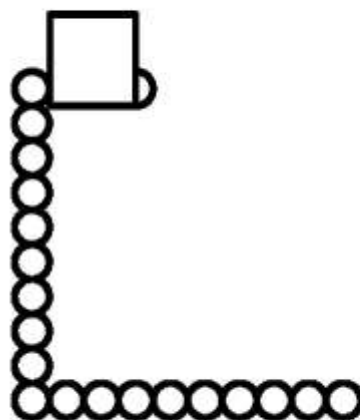
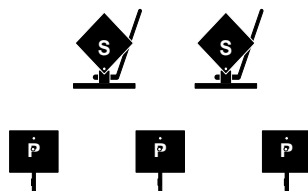

BEGIN standing at center table with both hands touching a 2x4 post. Pistols are holstered. Rifle is staged on center table. Shotgun is staged on any table.

LINE: "I use a Dave Denham rig"

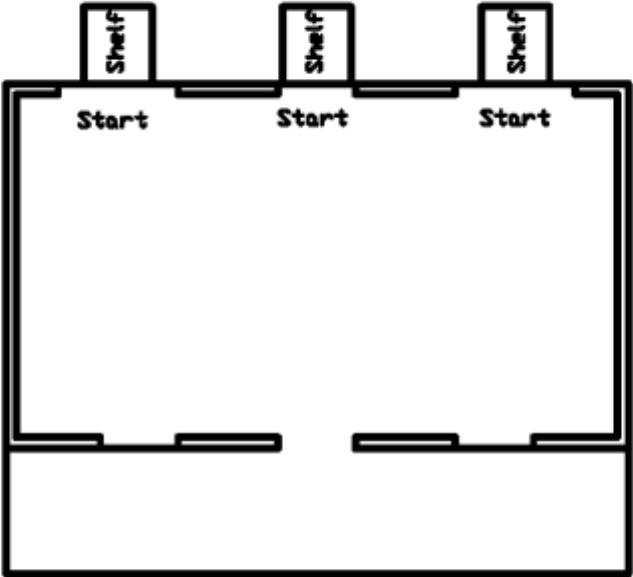
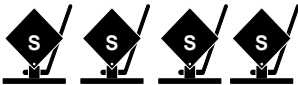
At the Buzzer:

- ❖ Gun order is rifle first.
- ❖ Rifle shot from center table between the two up rights. Starting on either end rifle target triple tap R1, quad tap R2, triple tap R3.
- ❖ Pistols shot from left table. Starting on either end pistol target triple tap P1, quad tap P2, triple tap P3.

R1 and P1 are the end targets you put the first round on.

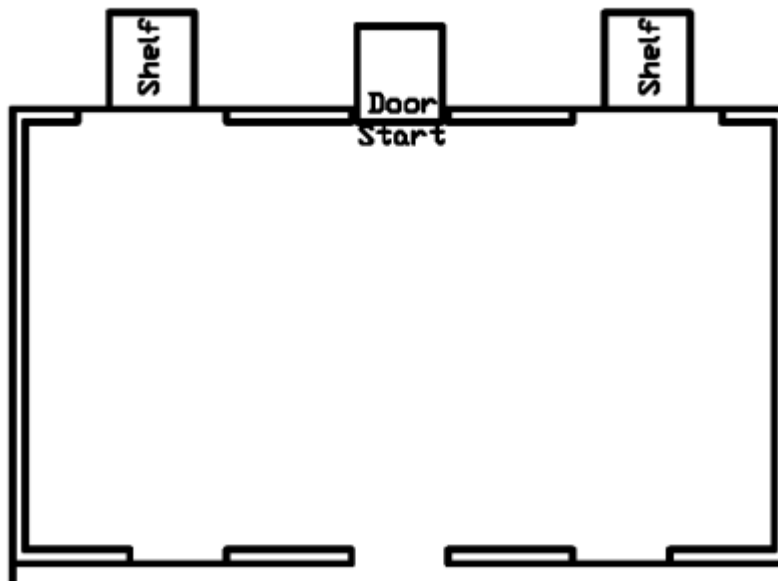
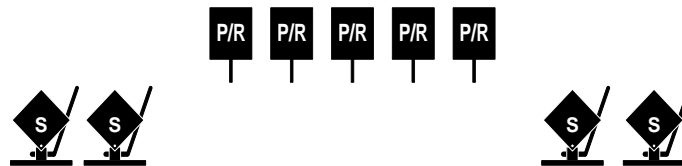
