As of today, July 3, 2024, I call for the nominations of State Administrative Committee members. The position descriptions and criteria are below.

Central Sectional Rep – 2-year term

- Actively worked for the past 2 years at a Washington State Club.
- Must work within the North Sectional boundaries.
- Assumes responsibility to communicate with all Club owners, coaches, and judges in your Section.
- Must be present at Sectional competitions, State Championships and State Congress.

East Sectional Rep – 2-year term

- Actively worked for the past 2 years at a Washington State Club.
- Must work within the South Sectional boundaries.
- Assumes responsibility to communicate with all Club owners, coaches, and judges in your Section.
- Must be present at Sectional competitions, State Championships and State Congress.

Compulsory Program Rep – 2-year term

- Actively coached for the past 2 years at a Washington State Club.
- A current Compulsory level Coach.
- Assumes responsibility to communicate with all club owners and coaches on business pertaining to Optional athletes.
- Assist Educational Rep with the planning of State Congress.
- Must be present at Optional State Championships and State Congress.

Education Rep/Secretary – 2-year term

- A member who has been actively involved as a Washington State USA Gymnastics member for the past 4 years.
- Assumes responsibility for the Washington State Clinic/Congress.
- Has served on the USA Gymnastics State Administrative Committee for at least 2 years.
- Works with the Program Reps to further educational opportunities for Athletes, Coaches and Judges in the State of Washington.
- Assumes the responsibility of taking minutes at all State meetings and assures they are distributed to the USAGWA membership.
- Tracks athletes for mobility and qualifying scores to Championship meets.
- When called upon, maintain the state website and social media.

Per Operating Code, State Administrative Committee members must be a minimum of 21 years of age and active in our state's program. Nominations will close on July 19th, 2024. Candidate statements will be posted online, and elections will be held online from July 24th, 2024, to August 9th, 2024. Newly elected officers will begin their term August 31st.

Please make sure I receive all nominations by July 19th, 2024. If there is only one qualified nominee for any position, I, as the State Chairman will cast one vote and no general election will be necessary.
