— Dependence on God Through Prayer Advanced Teaching Outline

I. DOCTRINE STATEMENT — PRAYER UNDER AUTHORITY, WARFARE, AND DELAY

- Prayer is disciplined dependence that governs authority, warfare, and endurance under delay. (Dan 10:12–14; Eph 6:18, summaries)
- God advances His purposes through intercessory servants. (Ezek 22:30; Luke 18:7–8, summaries)
- Prayer preserves alignment when human control fails. (Ps 20:7; Prov 16:9, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Prayer governs unseen realities.

II. PRAYER AND SPIRITUAL WARFARE

- Prayer enforces God’s will against resistance. (Matt 16:19; Eph 6:12, summaries)
- Delays do not indicate denial. (Dan 10:12–13; Hab 2:3, summaries)
- Authority is exercised through submission. (James 4:7; 1 Pet 5:6–9, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Prayer is an instrument of warfare.

III. PRAYER AND AUTHORITY

- Leaders must pray to govern righteously. (1 Tim 2:1–2; Prov 21:1, summaries)
- Prayer precedes major judgments and decisions. (Acts 13:2–3; Neh 1:4–11, summaries)
- Authority collapses without dependence. (Zech 4:6; Ps 127:1, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Authority requires prayer.

IV. PRAYER AND DELAYED ANSWERS

- God uses delay to refine faith. (Isa 30:18; Eccl 7:8, summaries)
- Perseverance separates faithful servants. (Luke 18:1–8; Rom 12:12, summaries)
- Appointed times cannot be rushed. (Hab 2:3; Eccl 3:11, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Delay matures dependence.

V. PRAYER AND CONSECRATION

- Effective prayer flows from holiness. (Ps 24:3–4; Isa 59:1–2, summaries)
- Consecration sharpens spiritual clarity. (Rom 12:1–2; 2 Tim 2:21, summaries)
- Hidden compromise weakens prayer. (Prov 28:13; Ps 66:18, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Purity sustains prayer.

VI. PRAYER AND INTERCESSORY BURDEN

- Intercessors carry responsibility for others. (Exod 32:11–14; Job 42:10, summaries)
- God searches for standing servants. (Ezek 22:30; Isa 62:6–7, summaries)
- Intercession alters outcomes. (James 5:16; Amos 7:1–6, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Intercession shapes history.

VII. PRAYER AND ENDURANCE

- Prayer sustains servants under prolonged strain. (Ps 27:14; Isa 40:31, summaries)
- Weariness invites vulnerability. (Matt 26:41; Gal 6:9, summaries)
- God renews strength through waiting. (Lam 3:31–33; Ps 130:5–6, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Prayer sustains endurance.
