## **— Endurance in Adversity Intermediate Teaching Outline**

### **I. DOCTRINE STATEMENT — ENDURANCE AS COVENANT PERSEVERANCE**

- Endurance is covenant faithfulness sustained through pressure, delay, and loss. (Heb 10:36; Rom 5:3–5, summaries)
- God uses adversity to mature His servants. (Deut 8:2; James 1:2–4, summaries)
- Perseverance protects long-term obedience. (Matt 24:13; Prov 24:16, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Endurance sustains covenant obedience.
