

# **OBEDIENCE TO GOD’S COMMANDS — UNCOMPROMISING ALIGNMENT**

## **— Fruitfulness in Righteous Deeds Beginner Teaching Outline**

### **I. DOCTRINE STATEMENT — WHAT FRUITFULNESS IS**

- Fruitfulness is visible obedience that produces righteous results. (Matt 7:17–20; John 15:8, summaries)
- God expects His servants to bear fruit that honors Him. (Gen 1:28; Titus 3:8, summaries)
- True fruit glorifies God and benefits others. (Matt 5:16; Col 1:10, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Fruit reveals obedience.

### **II. GOD AS THE SOURCE OF FRUIT**

- God gives increase; servants cultivate obedience. (1 Cor 3:6–7; Ps 127:1, summaries)
- Fruitfulness flows from abiding in God. (John 15:4–5; Ps 1:1–3, summaries)
- Human effort alone cannot produce lasting fruit. (Prov 16:9; Eccl 2:11, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: God produces lasting fruit.

### **III. FRUITFULNESS AND OBEDIENCE**

- Obedience precedes fruitfulness. (Deut 28:1–2; John 14:15, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Daily faithfulness bears fruit.

### **V. FRUITFULNESS AND GOOD WORKS**

- Good works confirm living faith. (James 2:17; Titus 3:14, summaries)
- God prepared good works beforehand. (Eph 2:10; Prov 16:3, summaries)
- Fruitful works bless others. (Prov 3:27; Heb 13:16, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Fruit benefits others.

## VI. FRUITFULNESS AND PERSEVERANCE

- Fruit often develops over time. (Ps 92:12–14; Eccl 3:1, summaries)
- Weariness tests perseverance. (Gal 6:9; Prov 24:10, summaries)
- God rewards steadfast faithfulness. (Matt 25:21; Rev 14:13, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Perseverance matures fruit.

## VII. SERVANT IDENTITY MARKERS

- Fruitful servants remain faithful. (Luke 8:15; Prov 20:7, summaries)
- Fruitful servants glorify God. (John 15:8; Ps 115:1, summaries)
- Fruitful servants bless others. (Prov 11:30; Matt 10:8, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Fruit identifies true servants.
