— Fruitfulness in Righteous Deeds Advanced Teaching Outline

I. DOCTRINE STATEMENT — FRUITFULNESS UNDER AUTHORITY, PRESSURE, AND JUDGMENT

- Fruitfulness is sustained obedience that produces lasting righteous impact under authority, pressure, and accountability. (John 15:16; Matt 25:21, summaries)
- God evaluates fruit by faithfulness and alignment, not scale. (1 Cor 4:2; Luke 16:10)
- Eternal reward corresponds to righteous fruit. (Rev 14:13; Eccl 12:14, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Fruitfulness must endure scrutiny.

II. FRUITFULNESS AND DIVINE SOVEREIGNTY

Teaching Emphasis: Character protects fruit.

Teaching Emphasis: Sacrifice produces fruit.

- Delayed fruit tests endurance. (Hab 2:3; Eccl 7:8, summaries)
- Faithfulness outlasts visibility. (Luke 8:15; Rev 2:10, summaries)
- God rewards perseverance. (Matt 25:21; Rev 14:13, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Endurance secures reward.

VII. FRUITFULNESS AND FINAL ACCOUNTABILITY

- Every work will be evaluated. (Eccl 12:14; 2 Cor 5:10, summaries)
- Faithful fruit endures eternally. (1 Cor 3:13–15; John 15:16, summaries)
- Loss results from wasted stewardship. (Matt 25:24–30; Prov 19:15, summaries)

Teaching Emphasis: Fruit carries eternal weight.
