The RSU 22 Education Foundation was established in August 2009, taking inspiration from endowment funds set up by universities nationwide.

The goal was to establish an organization that would become an integral and enduring part of the school district's educational structure.

The Foundation began to take shape slowly, with the initiation of fundraisers and the implementation of a program allowing teachers to apply for "mini-grants" to enhance classroom learning and inspire students.

As part of these formative years, a website was set up to spread awareness of the Education Foundation's purpose.

Additionally, temporary funding enabled the hiring of a part-time coordinator to oversee activities. At one point before the pandemic, the RSU 22 Education Foundation operated as a self-funded entity, accomplishing all its goals with an all-volunteer board.
