You may qualify if you are:

- Pregnant
- Breastfeeding
- A mother with a baby less than six months old
- A parent/guardian with a child under five years of age

WIC provides federal grants to states for supplemental foods, health care referrals, and nutrition education for low-income pregnant, breastfeeding, and non-breastfeeding postpartum women, and to infants and children up to age five who are found to be at nutritional risk.

Families must meet income guidelines and have nutritional need.
