We have been in a suspended state during this period with the board meeting occasionally to keep current with our regular business; bank statements, tax filings, insurance deadlines and contributions of items needed for our new areas.

Our new store is located in the former community room. The area is much smaller than our original store which had a patio & amp; shed for sorting and storage. With this limited space we will have to adapt and adjust operations. Storage will be our greatest challenge in this space.


