### 1. Apologies.

No apologies had been received.

### 2. **Declarations of Interest**

#### **Public Forum** 3.

The Chairman explained that the only item being considered at this meeting was a planning application for reserved matters for two dwellings at Ravenscroft, Main Road. Outline permission had been given in 2016 for two dwellings, so this application dealt with the design and exact location of the properties on the plot. The PC was therefore only able to consider these matters and respond to the Borough Council (BC) consultation on these issues. Members of the public made several comments in objection to the proposed dwellings and the Chairman explained that it was only items which were classed as material planning considerations which affected the decision made by the BC, and therefore PC comments would be restricted to these matters. Residents were given in excess of the 15 minutes allowed in the Standing Orders for public participation with the Chairman expressing several times that the PC were unable to consider any matters outside the issues that he had already clarified. Objections raised by residents which could be material planning considerations were:

- French doors on first floor overlooking neighbours' gardens.
- Side elevation to neighbours should be windowless on first floor.
- Footpath in front of properties needs to be installed as a continuation of current footpath in front of Fairswell Manor.
- Style of proposed dwellings is not in keeping with the area.
