

NEW THERAPY

Since my hysterectomy surgery last spring, I have been trying to not only improve my gait pattern, hand function, arm strength, but also keep my pain levels under control in my left knee and hip. It all started after my hysterectomy last spring and no definite solution yet. I appreciate my team's consistent help, and we have been trying strengthening exercises along with something new to me called dry needle therapy. It is similar to acupuncture. By inserting needles into the tight muscles from neuro-spasticity, it gets them to relax. In addition to therapy, I have had two rounds of cortisone shots in my hip and knee joint. We continue to monitor, exercise, and look for a solution.
