SWAN REHAB AND MONTHLY STROKE SUPPORT GROUP



I am so glad to have therapy assistance from my new team at SWAN Rehab in Goodyear. We continue to work both on my upper extremity range of motion, gait pattern, and knee/hip pain. We have found good results from the dry needling procedure, and I am amazed at both medicine and what the latest discoveries are and the body and its reaction to the different things we try. I continue to work at SWAN twice a week for two hours a time and then on my own home therapy program.

The Goodyear location started a stroke support group that meets for about 45 minutes once a month. This support group is so good for survivors to have the opportunity to connect with other survivors, gain information from professionals that come as speakers, and have a safe place to ask their questions outside of their therapy program. This is such an important and needed resource and I am thankful the clinic started this group.

VENDOR EVENT


