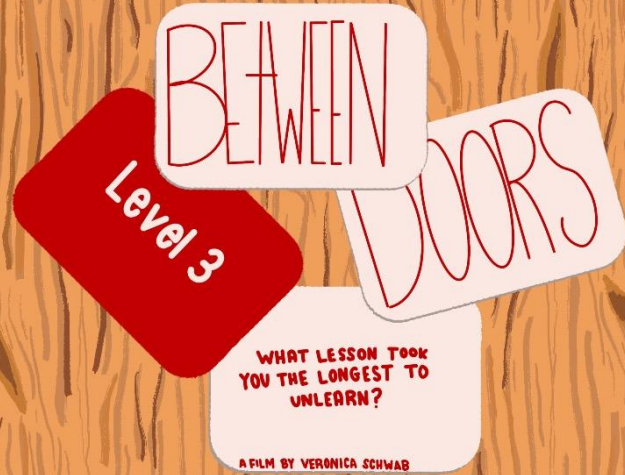

BETWEEN DOORS: **A Psychological** **Thriller**

SYNOPSIS

Juliette is sitting at a dimly lit restaurant, waiting for her date to show up. Felix walks through the exit door into the restaurant. Juliette is confused by this but chooses to ignore it. Felix suggests they play a purpose driven game so they're date goes smoother. Juliette is relieved by this because she is anxious at the beginning of the date. They begin to ask each other questions from the card game and they have seemingly normal conversations with each other at first. As the game continues Felix reveals that he is in a cult-like community which has gotten him out of his chaotic past. He also begins to interrogate Juliette which leads her to reveal her dark secret. Felix gets her to reveal that she has killed her ex-boyfriend who was competing with her for an internship position at a top car company. Her ex was making more progress in the competition than her. Therefore, she felt like she wasn't going to earn the position if she didn't do something, which lead to her killing her boyfriend at the time.



SYNOPSIS

After revealing this information, Juliette seeks the advice of Felix because her guilty conscience is overwhelming her. Felix gives Juliette two choices: to continue living with guilt or to begin a new path in Felix's community where they would help her and not judge her for her past mistakes. This choice is represented by the entrance door (first choice) and the exit door (second choice). The final card in the deck is information about Felix's community where he emphasizes that it is ultimately up to Juliette what path she chooses and he leaves out the exit door. Juliette's real date comes through the entrance door after Felix has left. He explains to Juliette why he was running late but Juliette isn't able to pay attention to him because she is in such shock from her confession and how she now must make a choice. She then gets up from the table and walks out the exit door, the same way Felix does.
