

# TENTATIVE SCHEDULE



Dear Ice Show Families,

The following packet contains important information for our annual Ice Show. This will be an exciting and action-packed 6 weeks as we prep and practice for the big show. Enclosed you will find the group number(s) your child will be skating in along with the Ice Show Practice Schedule and Show Week Schedule. Please read over this important information carefully! Some requests/rules regarding ice show and the practices:

- ★ Parents are expected to be present at all practices. The week of ice show – April 27th-30th, **practices are closed to spectators**. Unless you have volunteered to help, parents are asked to sign in their children/skaters and then leave the arena. We will have monitors to ensure the care and safety of the children. If you feel you must be with your skater, volunteer sign-ups for locker room monitors will be available. Volunteer information coming soon.
- ★ **No food or drinks allowed in the locker rooms.** One spill could ruin someone's costume!
- ★ Skaters are **not allowed** in the stands during the half of the show that they are skating, but are **encouraged** to sit in the stands for the half of the show that they are not performing in.
- ★ During the show, skaters are to remain in the hallway with their groups. If the skater is performing in both halves, they must remain in the hallway for the duration of the show. **This is for their security and the smooth running of the show, we don't want anyone to miss their moment in the spotlight!**
- ★ Please have your skater bring a bathrobe/cover-up. Once in costume, they should wear their cover-up if they venture to the restroom/lobby during intermission.
- ★ Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your scheduled practice time; for **on-ice** practices, skaters need to be **ready with skates on at their designated start time. First TWO weeks of practices are entirely OFF-ICE, so TENNIS SHOES are required.**
- ★ Skaters are to wear appropriate practice attire. No loose or baggy pants or tops – they can be a hazard or obstruction to the skater or the other skaters in their group.
- ★ Skaters, please pull your hair back and up/out of your face.
- ★ Skaters must submit a Google absentee form for practices they know they will miss. **After one absence per number, a skater must arrange a private lesson with the choreographer of that number and pay that coach their private lesson fee.**

# TENTATIVE SCHEDULE

NOTE: By signing up for the Annual Ice Show, parents and skaters have agreed to the following: Parents/Skaters are expected to treat all skaters and guests with respect at all times. Any deliberate harassment of a skater or guest may result in punitive action up to and including expulsion from the ice show. Disciplinary action procedure will follow the conflict resolution that is stated in the Wayne Westland Figure Skating Club bylaws. Thank you in advance for following these recommendations. By doing so, we will have a safe and fun ice show experience to remember! We'll be doing the cast photo pre-sale again this year. Orders will be digital/Google forms again.

We'll be holding a PRE-SALE for ice show program books again as well. There will be a limited quantity available for purchase at the show. For those new to the ice show, we do have a couple program books from past year's shows in the "INFORMATION STATION" at the rink for you to peruse as examples, so you'll at least have a general idea on what you can expect. The ice show program book contains pictures of the group numbers and the rest of the show cast, the skate/show order, skater ads from friends and family, and ads from local businesses. ## ICE SHOW VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS:

A member of each skater's family must volunteer for an ice show staff position. Around 6 hours minimum are required per family and **MANDATORY participation in set-up and tear-down. There is a fine of \$100 per family if this requirement is not met.** This tends to be the equivalent of 2-3 time slots/jobs. An ice show volunteer sign-up will be posted online in the spring, details and a link will be provided via email. SkateSafe certification is required for many of the volunteer positions. More information about SkateSafe requirements will be provided in a separate volunteer sign-up email. **Since we always struggle with show date volunteers, one of the required time slots is to be on a show/performance day.** Those volunteering on a show night will receive free admission to one of the other performances.

All ice show participants are encouraged to participate in the SPRING Schwartz Greenhouse gift card fundraiser to help cover costs of show expenses. Details are posted on our website's "fundraiser" and "ice show" tabs.
