

Re-Opening Plan for Mike Modano Ice Arena

Facility Entry/Procedures

- Arrive NO MORE than 15 minutes prior to your scheduled time
- Skaters and Parents will enter thru main lobby doors. There will be a monitor station upon entry. Temperature check will also be administered, if above 100.4 F, you will be asked to leave the arena. Health Screening questionnaire must be completed.
- There will be designated seating areas to put skates on (Hallway to locker rooms, etc.)
- Lobby and bleachers will be marked with proper seating distances
- Limit one parent entering building during practices
- Masks will be required while in building
- There will be sanitizer throughout building
- Must maintain 6ft distance at ALL times
- Skaters should come fully dressed other than skates and helmets
- Guests are asked to stay home if feeling ill
- We ask that you leave building within 10 minutes after your scheduled ice time
- Showers will be Closed.
- Drinking Fountains will be Closed.

Staff

- Employees showing any symptoms or signs of sickness, or who have been in contact with known positive cases will be told to stay home
- Employee symptom screening questions and workplace temperature monitoring will occur before each shift
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) will provided to all employees
- Employees will be required to wear masks and disposable gloves at work
- Develop physical distancing policies and procedures for staff interactions
- Limit areas that employees can congregate
- Space work shifts and breaks to control number of employees in facility

Cleaning

- All high traffic areas of the facility will be disinfected frequently
- Locker rooms will be sanitized after each use
- Rest Rooms will be cleaned hourly
- Lobby tables and chairs will be disinfected frequently
- Concession counter will be disinfected frequently
- Skate rentals & skating aids will be disinfected after each use
- Faucets, door handles, credit card machine, mouse will be disinfected frequently

Locker Rooms

- Locker Rooms will be available 15 minutes prior to and 10 minutes after scheduled ice time
- There will be additional seating in locker room hallway
- NO SHOWERS will be available for use
- Please maintain 6ft distance while changing

ON ICE

- It is the responsibility of the coach to follow the set guidelines that USA Hockey & US Figure Skating has provided in their re-opening plan document. If these rules are not adhered to, you will be asked to leave the ice surface.
- Use different doors when leaving ice surface
- Please do not hang around arena after your session
- No spitting on the ice

WHA

- Players will come fully dressed other than skates/gloves/helmets
- Skaters must wear a mask until they step on the ice.
- Stay 6ft apart when doing drills
- No handshakes or sharing of water bottles
- Wash hands frequently
- Eliminate chalk talks
- Coach must wear a mask

WHOH

- No coolers allowed in building
- Skaters must wear mask until they step on the ice.
- No showers will be available
- No handshakes and sharing of water bottles

Figure Skating Freestyle

- Coaches may not skate along skater
- Chairs are placed to allow for social distancing when putting skates on. Please do NOT move the chairs.
- 20 skaters per 50 minute session
- Skaters must wear a mask until they step on the ice.
- Do not help a skater up unless absolutely necessary
- Coaches must be wearing a mask
- We encourage as few people in the building as possible. If skater can be dropped off and picked up-we ask that you consider doing so.
